' (NC56205271) Cups (Sculptured on Rock) (T.I.) (1).

' Cup marked Stone, Kinloch.

On the W. side of the road to Kinloch, about 1/2 ml. N. of the bridge over the Kinloch River, and on the N edge of a gravel pit close to the road, is a large, earth-fast boulder, 5' in length as far as exposed and 3'10" in breadth, showing on its upper surface 18 cup marks of various depths, of which the most distinct is towards the N end of the stone, measuring about 3" in diameter and 1" in depth. The whole length of the stone is not visible, but the markings do not seem to extend to the portion covered.' (2).
