Two small oval depressions lie on the SE side of a small corrie about half a mile NW of Blarich. One is 12' by 7' by 3' deep within a low bank. It is situated on a NW facing slope and on excavation, a flint flake  $\frac{1}{2}$ " by  $\frac{1}{2}$ " was recovered from a thin layer of charcoal beneath the turf. The other depression, situated about 40' to the W is of similar dimensions.
