The grid reference on the description isn't helpful but the full and eloquent text seems to indicate the buildings on the attached map just to the southeast of where it says "Bettyhill" - natural port in the headland to the north (no track visible though) and a pier to the south. Any ideas?

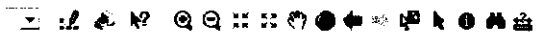
