'(NC 7370 0906) Cist.' (1)
 ' A cist, 3ft 8ins long (1.21m), 2ft wide (0.61m) and 1ft 10ins deep (c0.305m), formed of four flat slabs, is exposed between two great, earth-fast boulders about 8ft(2.44m) apart, the longer of which is 15ft (4.68m) long. The cist does not appear to have been covered by a cairn.' (2).
 'A cist as described by the RCAHM.' (OSFI: WDJ: 15.4.1964).

 'The cist is as described. It is set into the top of a slight rise in the sides of which protrude three massive boulder-erratics to partiall enclose the cist. Published Survey (1;10 000) correct.' (OSFI: JM 31.8.1981).
