' NC 72670208: Stone Circle.' (1).
 'Stone Circle, Pittentrail. The OS map indicates the site of a stone circle near Pittentrail Bridge. The site is now built over' (2).
 'At Pittentrail, on a commanding hillock, stand the remains of a large chambered cairn, with its entrance turned to the NE '(3). This monument is marked on the 6" map as 'stone circle remains of' and is noted in the Inventory (4). by which time the site had been built over. It consisted of six stones, three of which are standing the remainder are lying. They are placed in a circle about 11ft in diameter and on a small mound ...in an arable field adjacent to Pittentrail Inn.' (5) (6).
 'No trace of the cairn is now to be seen. Mr. Mackay, Corry, Rogart. pointed out the spot, coincident with the published site, where rubble stones have been ploughed up on top of a slight knoll'. (OSFI:NKB:17.2.1966). (over).
