

**IN THE MATTER OF THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS
ACTS, 1913 AND 1931.**

To **Ascoile Limited, per J. Sutherland, Esq., Factor,
Dornoch, Sutherland,**

the owners of the Monument known as "Caisteal na Coille" (broch) situated on the east or left bank of the Black Water, 300 yards west-south-west of the Balnacoll-Achaness road at its nearest point, and 370 yards north-north-west of the point where a burn flowing eastward to the north of Cnoc Cille Pheadair joins said water being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as **Gordonbush Grazing Farm**

situated in the Parish of **Clyne** and
County of **Sutherland.**

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Works and Public Buildings hereby give you notice that it is their intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by them under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

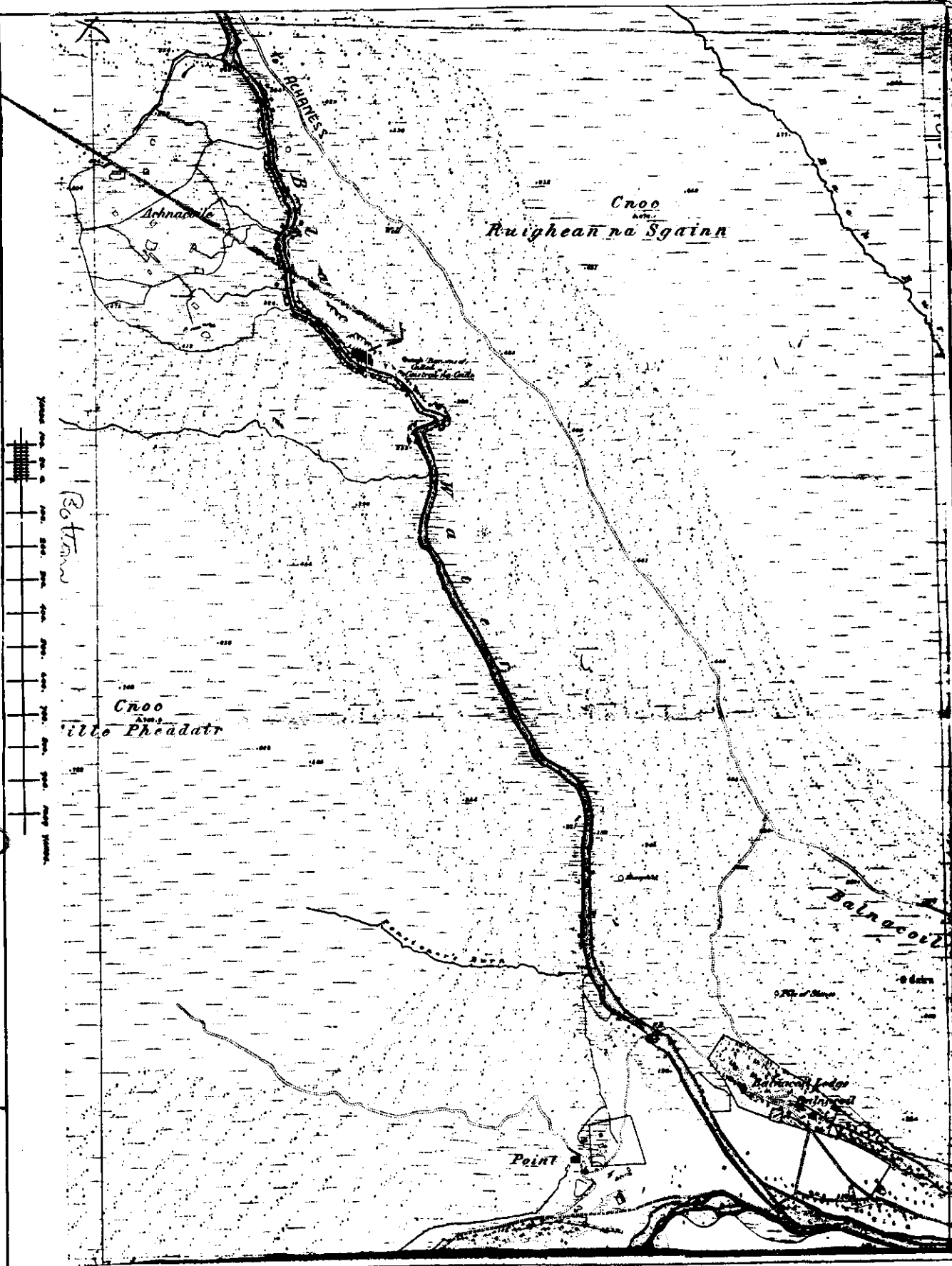
