## IN THE MATTER OF THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS ACTS, 1913 AND 1931.

To Sir Walter Ernest Hargreaves of Skelpick, per Messieurs  
A.N. MacAulay and Company, Solicitors in Golspie,

the owner of the Monument known as the Broch (or Brough) occupying a circular area of ground measuring seventy yards in diameter, the southmost point of said area being situated sixty yards north-west by north of the Allt a' Chais-teil at its nearest point, five hundred and ten yards east-north-east of the junction of said stream with the north-east or right bank of the Skelpick Burn and seven hundred yards south-south-east at its nearest point of the stream flowing between Lochan Airidh Creagain and Lochan Duinte,

being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of

the property known as the Farm of Skelpick

situated in the Parish of Farr and

County of Sutherland.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Works and Public Buildings hereby give you notice that it is their intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by them under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

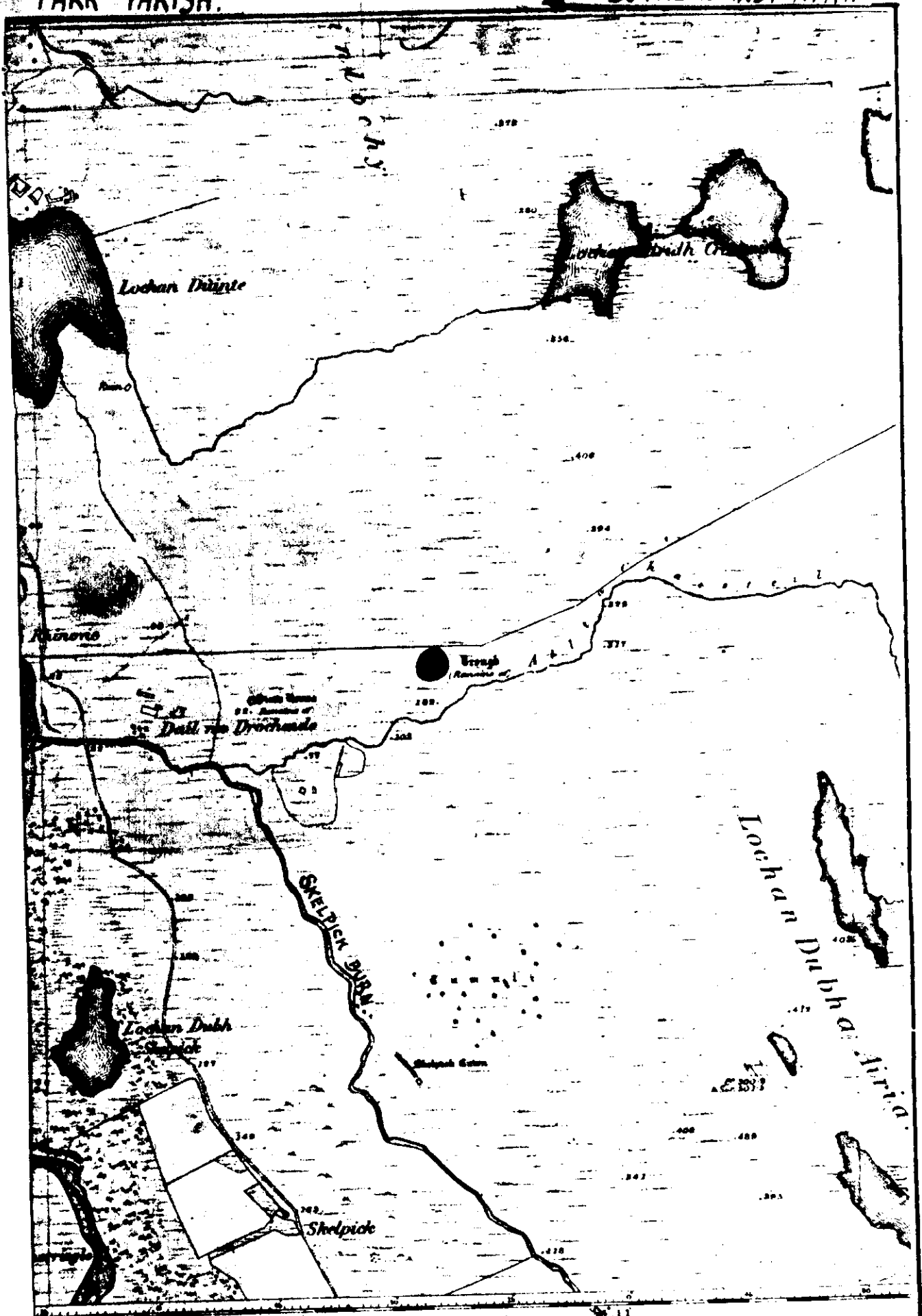
