Macaulay and Company, Solicitors, Colspie, Sutherland, the owner of the Monument known as the Hut Circle occupying a circular area of ground measuring twenty yards in diameter, the westmost point of said area being situated forty feet east of the road between Helmsdale and Kinbrace at its nearest point, two hundred and ten yards north-east by east of the London Midland and Scottish Railway through the Strath of Kildonan at its nearest point and one thousand two hundred and thirty yards north-west by north of the north-west corner of the northmost block of buildings at Kinbrace Farm,

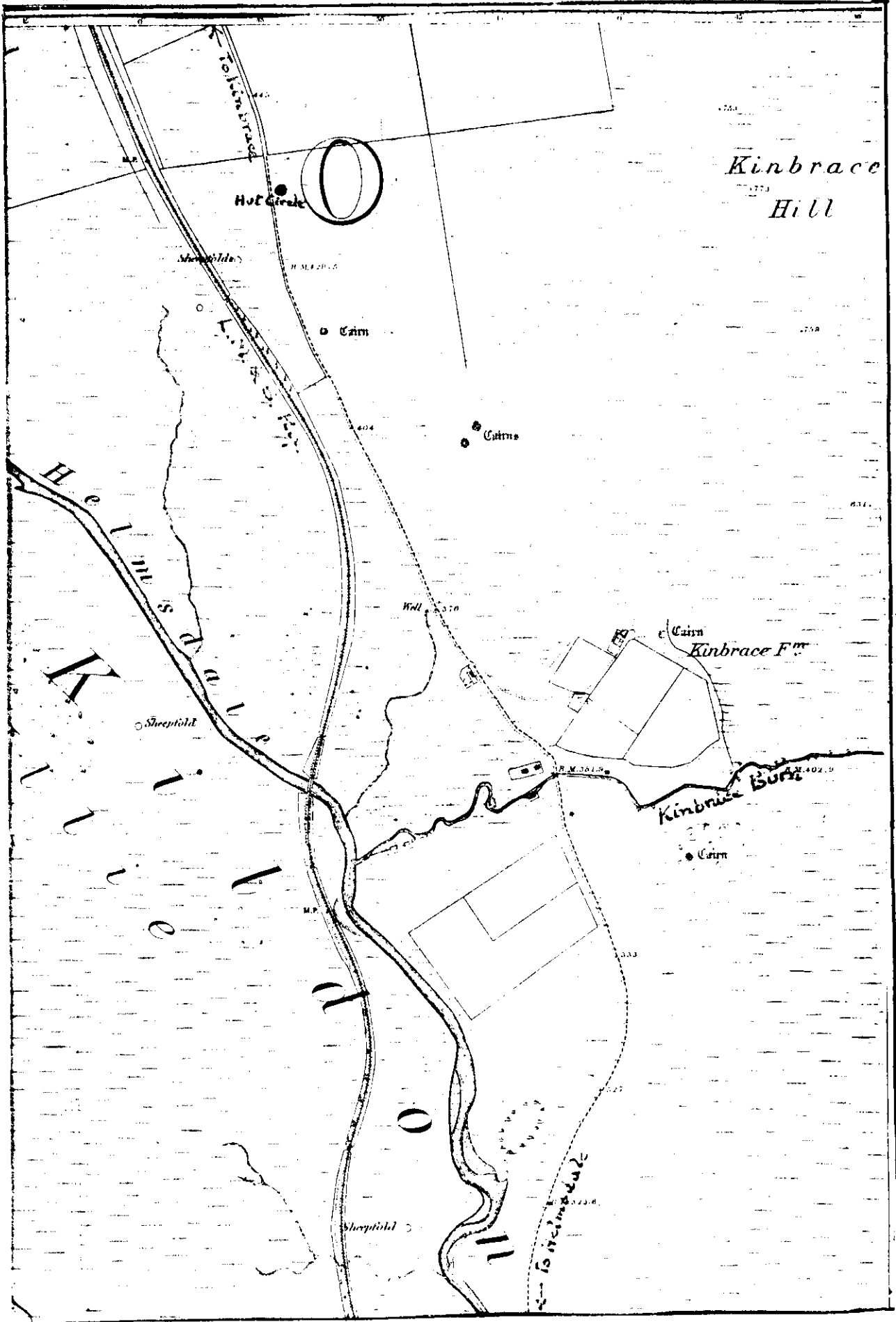
