"NC 89872351. Mound" (1)

"A probable cairn, overgrown with grass and heather, measuring 58' to 60' in diameter and 8' to 9' high." (2)

"A large, heather-covered mound as described by the RCAHM. slight excavation in the lower NW side indicates that it is probable natural, although several stones protrude. (OSFI:WDJ:29.5.1961)

"A good number of undoubtedly natural mounds occur in the vicinity especially to the south, supporting the probability of the mound's natural origin." (OSFI:JB:20.1.1976)
