



LEATHAD CARNAICH.

**IN THE MATTER OF THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS  
ACTS, 1913 AND 1931.**

To Colonel John Cabourn Hartley, per D. Keith Murray, Solicitor  
in Thurso,

the owner of the Monuments known as the Hut Circles and Mounds contained within an oval area of ground on Leathad Carnaich bounded on the south-east, south and south-west by the Alltan Geal along which it extends two hundred and fifty yards and measuring three hundred and ten yards at its greatest length from south-east to north-west and one hundred and eighty yards at its greatest width from north-east to south-west, the south-eastmost point of said area being situated two hundred and thirty yards east-north-east at its nearest point of the road between Melvich and Kinbrace, three hundred and twenty yards south-east of the bridge carrying said road over said Alltan Geal and four hundred yards north-north-east of the Post Office to the north of Dalhalvaig,

being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of

the property known as the lands and Estate of Bighouse and Others

situated in the Parish of Farr

and

County of Sutherland.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Works and Public Buildings hereby give you notice that it is their intention to include the Monuments above specified in a list of monuments to be published by them under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

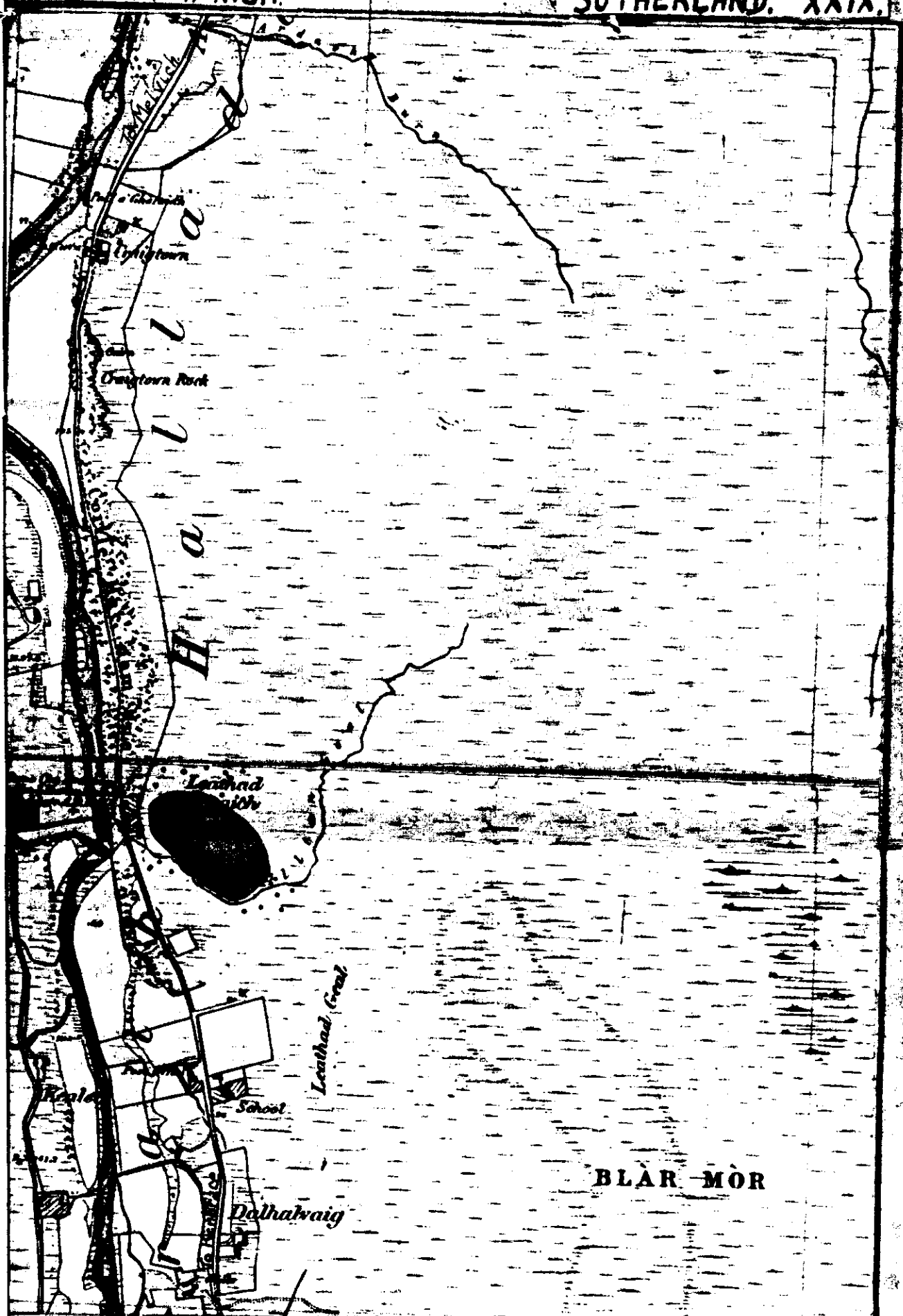

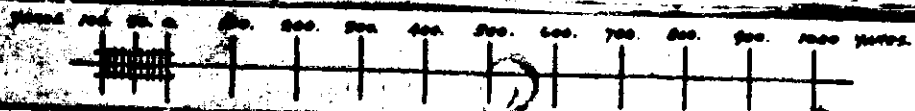
