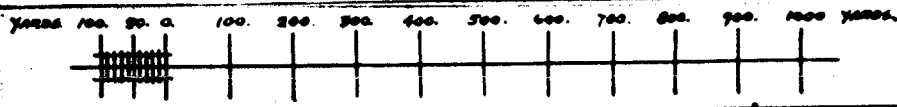
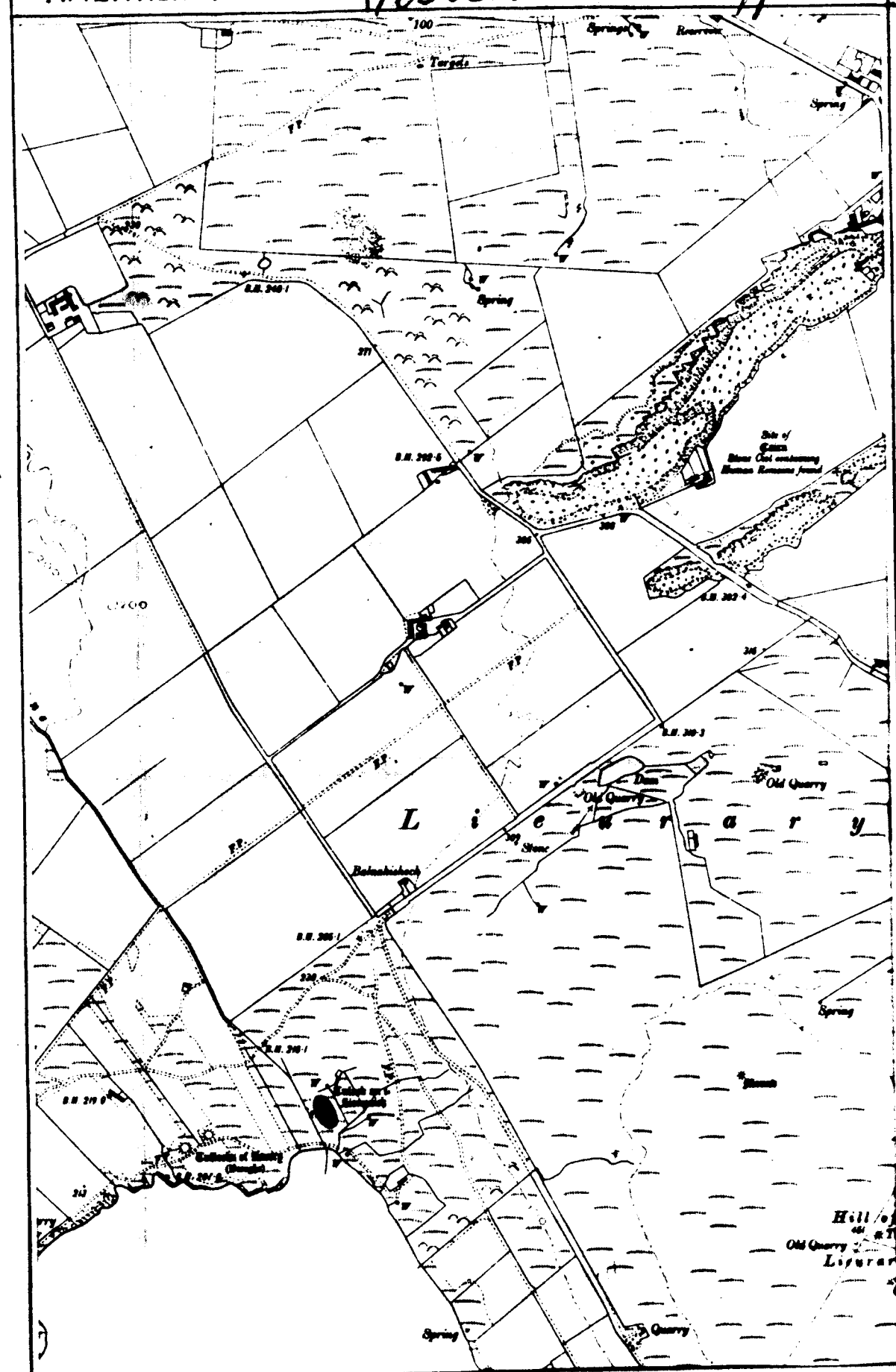

being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as Lieurary Farm

situated in the Parish of Halkirk and County of Caithness
