"ND 1474 2714. The Aisle (Grave Yard)." (1)

"About half an acre of ground enclosed by a stone wall, on the S side of the county road, and W of Allt na Caorach, said to have been a place of interment before the Reformation. It is known by some of the oldest inhabitants as 'Tuit Marian' (Grave of Marian) on account of a person of that name who fell over the rocks, having been buried in it last, but generally known now as 'The Aisle'. From minute inquiry no written record can be found. Information depends solely on the local informants consulted." (2)

" 'The Aisle' is now in use as a sheep fold. The interior is entirely featureless." (OSFI:WDJ:24.6.1960)
