"Broch, Knockinnon: On the W side of the road to Wick, and about a mile N of Dunbeath, a grassy mound marks the ruins of a broch. It is conical and has a diameter at base of 67ft (21.0m) and an elevation of 12 (3.7m) to 13ft (4.1m). On the N side, some 12ft (3.7m) distant from the supposed base of the tower, is a portion of an encircling wall or bank some 6ft (1.8m) high on the inner side, and 10ft (3.0m) on the outer face."
