"ND 1773 3396. Broch (remains of)." (1)

"Some 200yds (183m) N of the broch described on HND 13 SE 004, on the end of a rocky ridge, are the remains of numerous constructions. Near the centre there seems to have been a broch with a diam. over all of some 66ft (20.2m), but it is much dilapidated and the outline is not very evident. Its elevation is about 5ft (1.5m). On the N, S, and especially on the E, there are surface indications of numerous outbuildings." (2)

"The remains of a broch, 18.0m in diam. with secondary structures, as described by the RCAHMS." (OSFI:NKB:25.3.1968)

"This broch is reduced to turf-covered remains, 1.4m high. A portion of the outer face in the N arc, and the estimated line in the S, give a diam. of 18.0m. The court area is indicated /cont.
