"ND 1318 3315: Chambered cairn"(1)

"On the summit of Cnoc Na Maranaich are the remains of a large cairn about 18.4m in diameter and 2.2m maximum height. It is partially turf-covered, but the centre has been broken into. Amidst the chaos one large upright stone is visible, while a number of other similar slabs lie about. Their number and size strongly suggest that the cairn has covered a chamber."(2)(3)

"As described."(OSFI:WDJ:27.6.1960) "No change to previous field report. Three modern cairns surmount the chambered cairn and an old bothy structure abuts it on the NE side."
