"Well, 'Tobar Chalum-Cille': Due N of the graveyard and close to the shepherd's house at Diriot is a well bearing the above name." (1) "Information supplied by the Rev a Mackay of Westerdale)"

"ND 1261 4912. The only well noted close to Diriot has been enclosed by a square breeze-block wall and covered with two thin stone slabs. Local enquiries failed to ascertain if this was the 'Tobar Chalum-Cille'." (OSFI:WDJ:12.4.1961)

"The modernised well, published on (2) at ND 1261 4912, is as described by the previous field investigator. It is the only well known locally to fit the RCAHM description. The name 'Tobar Chalum-Cille' is unknown in the vicinity." (OSFI:JB:25.2.1982)
