To Major Sir Archibald Henry Macdonald Sinclair, Bart., of Ulbster, Thurso Castle, Thurso, Caithness.

the owner of the Monument known as "Tulloch of Milton" (remains of chambered cairn) measuring 100 feet from north to south and 76 feet from east to west situated 30 yards east of the river Thurso at its nearest point, 430 yards south-west of Milton, near Halkirk, and 350 yards south-east of Gerston, across said River,

being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as Milton Farm, Ulbster Estate,

situated in the Parish of Halkirk and County of Caithness.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Works and Public Buildings hereby give you notice that it is their intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by them under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act 1913.

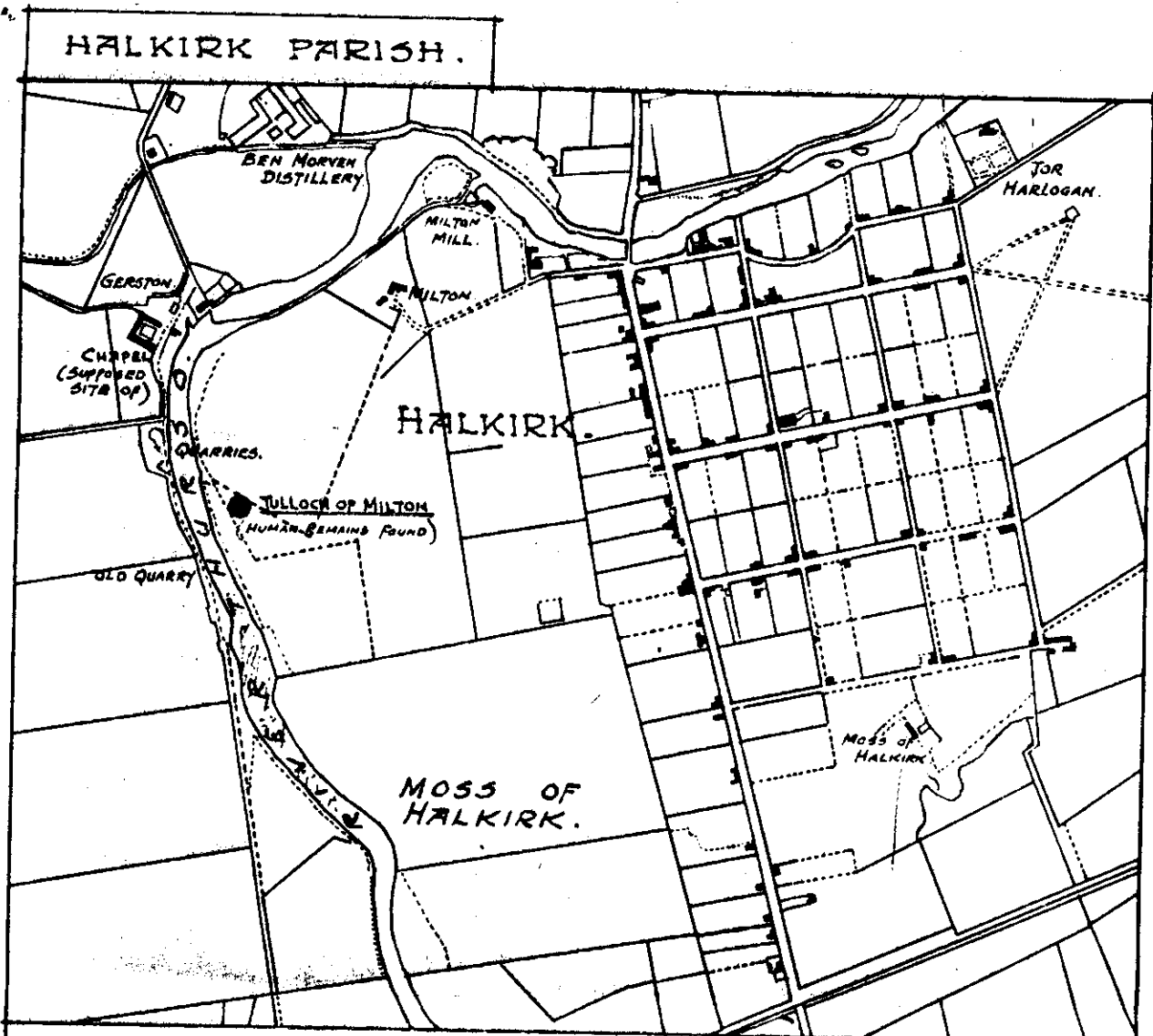

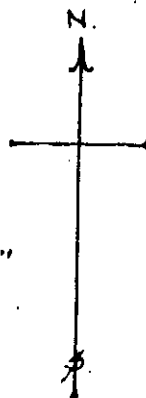

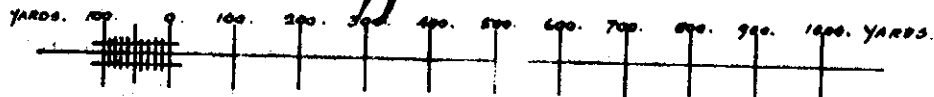
