Description. The cairn is on a terrace on the moorland hillside at a little over 168ft=51.5m 100ft. OD. The main axis lies ESE-WNW. It is about 168ft. long, 46ft. wide at the E end which appears to be straight rather than rounded in plan, and 27 ft. wide at the w end. Here it is only about 1 ft. high but it rises to a maximum of 7ft. near the E end. The cairn is of large irregular boulders and stones, bare of vegetation except where peat and heather are encroaching over the edges. It appears to be nearly intact except for an area which has been robbed about the centre of the s side and some disturbance at the E end. The latter has exposed, at 12ft. within the E edge, a large slab set on edge aligned along the main axis. It is 4ft. oin. long and at least 2ft. deep. Another large stone lies by it, obviously displaced. More of the structure of the chamber probably exists under the cairn material to the W of them. On the E edge and 18ft. from the s side there is a large boulder measuring 4ft. wide and 4ft. high.


SUT 15 CAEN BURN SOUTH Revisited 17.6.67 Plan by A.S.H. and M.K.M.

The cairn is 172 ft long overall, by 66 ft wide across the E end. From this end the sides narrow rapidly to a width of 40 ft at 56 ft from the end, and then narrow gradually to a width of about 26 ft at the w end. The E end is straight or very slightly concave, edged by a boulder kerb, including a particularly large stone 4 ft wide and 2 ft 6 in. high, just s of the centre. Cairn material extends 10 ft in front of this kerb. At intervals along the N side stones may be seen, apparently laid lengthwise, and possibly kerb stones. The plan of the w end is uncertain.

About 10 ft w of the kerb at the E end, and on the medial line, two overlapping upright slabs can just be seen amongst the cairn material, one 4 ft 9 in. long, the other rather smaller.
