

**IN THE MATTER OF THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS  
ACTS, 1913 AND 1931.**

To Patrick Wyndham Murray Threipland of Dale and Toftingall, Dale House, Halkirk,

the owner of the Monument known as the Broch (or Brough) occupying a circular area of ground at Mybster measuring fifty yards in diameter, the northmost point of said area being situated twenty yards south of the road between Westerdale and Mybster Inn at its nearest point, four hundred and thirty yards east-north-east of the north-east corner of the main block of buildings at Ballone and seven hundred and forty yards west by south of the junction of the south side of said road with the west side of the road between Thurso and Latheron at said Inn,

being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as Farm and lands of Ballone part of the lands and Estates of Dale and Toftingall

situated in the Parish of Halkirk and County of Caithness.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Works and Public Buildings hereby give you notice that it is their intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by them under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

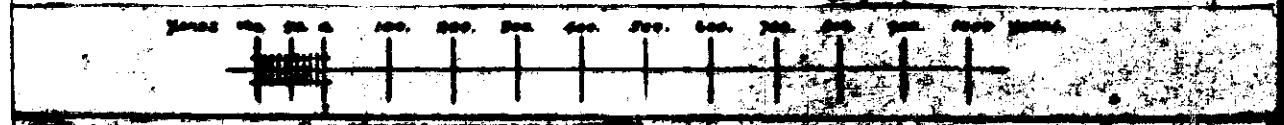
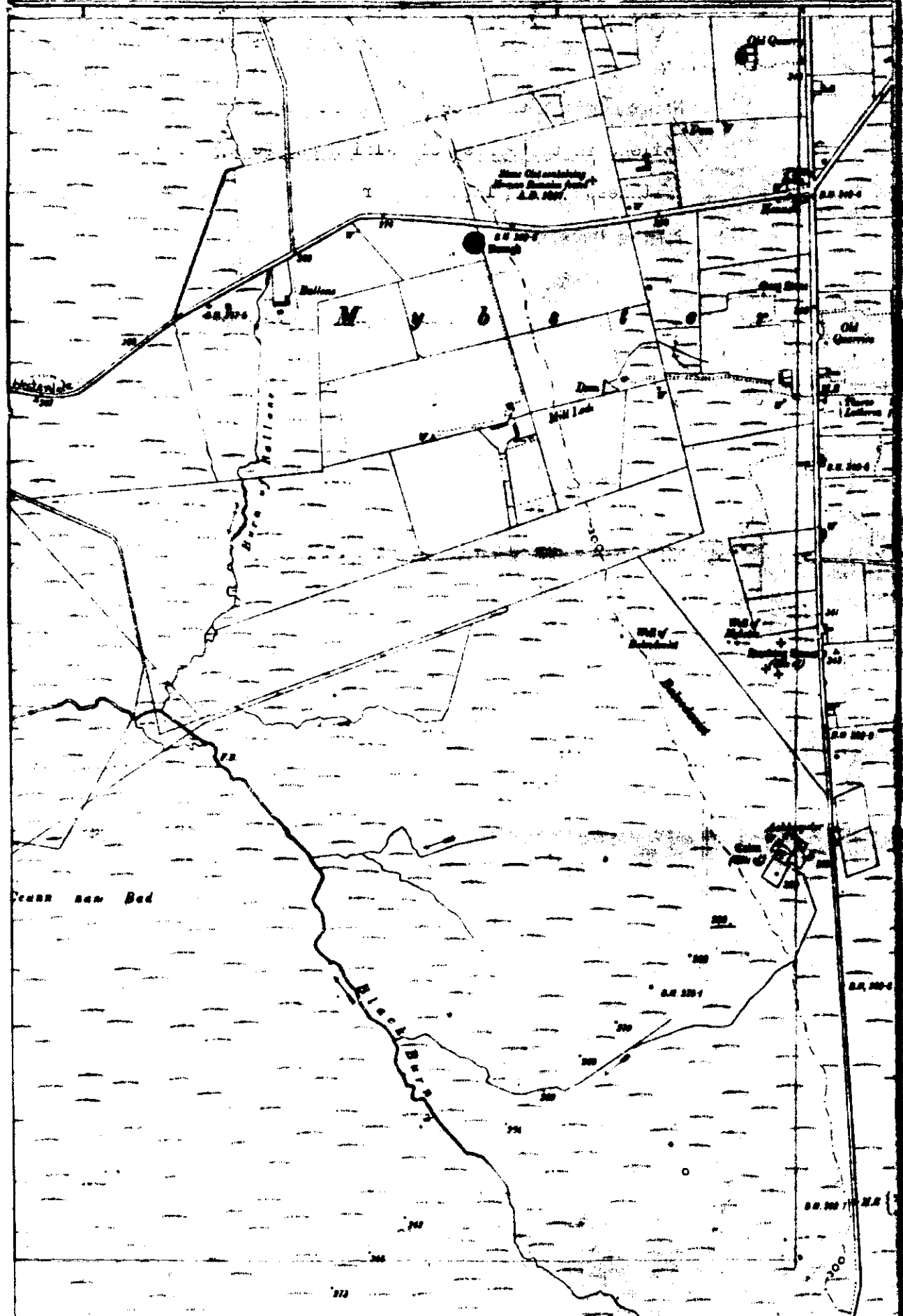
