 "ND 1112 5363. ST Peter's Chapel."(1) "On the left bank of the Olgrimbed Burn are the remains of St Peter's Chapel. The walls stand to a height of about 2ft(0.61m) and are 3ft(0.91m) in width. The interior dimensions are 24ft(7.44m) by 13ft(4.07m). There is no sign of a chancel nor are there any details to indicate the period of erection."(4)  
 "The remains of the chapel are as described above. Its overall dimensions are 10.7m by 5.8m. Nothing remains of its graveyard."(OSFI:EGC:15.4.1962)

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979  
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as St Peter's Chapel, Halkirk comprises the remains of a late medieval chapel, known as St Peter's, situated on the N bank of the Olgrinbeg Burn. The area to be scheduled is rectangular, measuring a maximum of 16.2m E-W by 8.2m N-S, to extend 2m from the exterior walls of the chapel. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Halkirk and the County of Caithness as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part of the subjects described in the Disposition by Robin MacDonald Sinclair Viscount Thurso of Webster in favour of John Munro and another dated 20 November 1985 and recorded in the Division of the General Register of Sasines for the County of Caithness on 5 March 1986 (the present owner whereof being John Munro and Catherine Elizabeth Sinclair or Munro, Lower Westerdale Farm, Westerdale, Halkirk, Caithness), is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

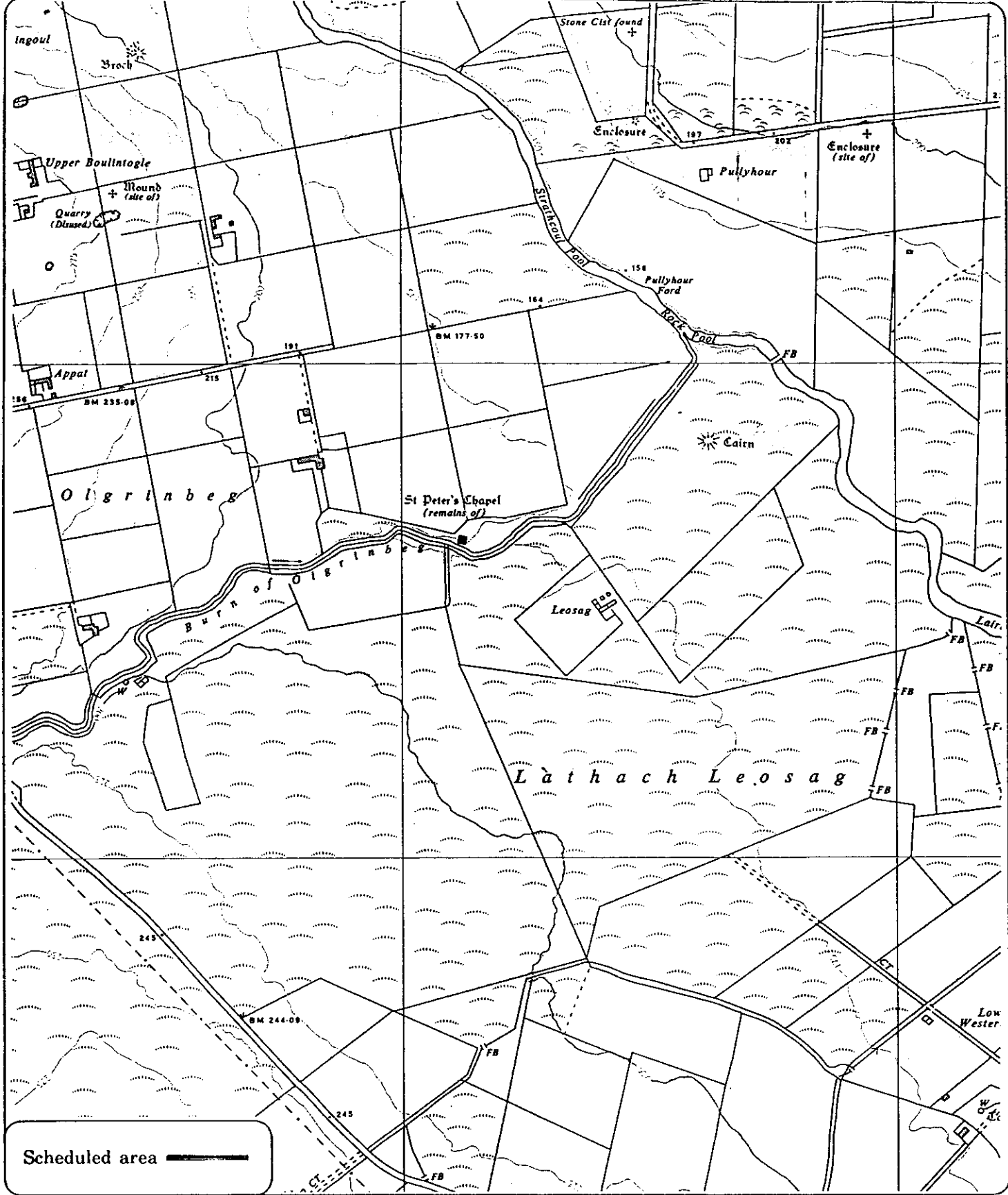

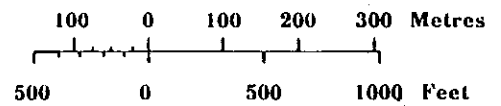
**St Peter's Chapel, Halkirk**
