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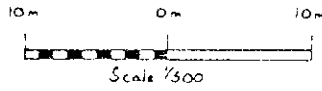
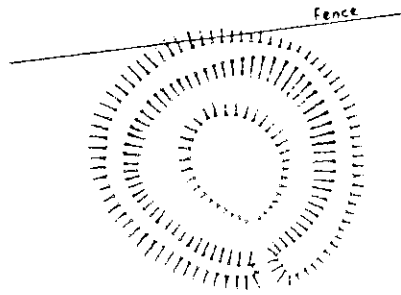

Tumulus."(1) "Some 200yds(183m) of Pullyhour, on a piece of waste ground, is a circular bank 8(2.44m) to 9ft(2.74m) thick and about 2ft(0.61m) high, enclosing an area about 43ft(13.2m) in diameter in the centre of which is a flat-topped mound 28ft(8.66m) in diameter and about 6"(0.2m) to 1ft(0.305m) in height. The whole is overgrown with turf, but it appears to be stony underneath. There is no break in the enclosing bank. Its character is doubtful."(2) "Generally as described above except that there is a slight gap in the outer bank on the S side, leading to a causeway across an inner ditch. This appears to be a hengiform enclosure."(OSFI:EGC: 16.4.1962) "ND 1147 5449. Enclosure."(3) "A hengiform earthwork, levelled into a gentle E-racing slope in rough pasture. It comprises a flat and featureless central area, 8.0m in diameter within a silted ditch and outer bank. The latter is 3.0m to 3.5m broad and varies from 0.2 to 0.8m above the bottom of the ditch; there is no trace of any stones protruding through the turf.
