

IN THE MATTER OF THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS ACTS, 1913 and 1931.

To The Right Honourable Major Sir Archibald Henry Macdonald Sinclair of Ulbster, Baronet, Thurso Castle, Thurso, the owner of the Monuments known as "Tulach an Fhuarain" and "Tulach Lochain Bhriseil" consisting of (First) "Tulach an Fhuarain" occupying a circular area of ground measuring forty yards in diameter, the eastmost point of said area being situated twenty yards west-south-west of the River Thurso at its nearest point, three hundred and seventy yards north-west by north of the Bench Mark 194.8 on the south-east parapet of the Bridge of Westerdale across said River and four hundred and eighty yards north of the Bench Mark 198.6 on the west gable of the present or former United Free Church at Westerdale and (Second) "Tulach Lochain Bhriseil" occupying a circular area of ground to the south-south-west of said Tulach an Fhuarain measuring forty yards in diameter, the eastmost point of said second mentioned area being situated eighty yards west-south-west of said River at its nearest point, three hundred and sixty yards north-west by west of said Bench Mark 194.8 and four hundred and thirty yards north by west of said Bench Mark 198.6, being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as the Farm and lands of Westerdale situated in the Parish of Halkirk and County of Caithness.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Works and Public Buildings hereby give you notice that it is their intention to include the Monuments above specified in a list of monuments to be published by them under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

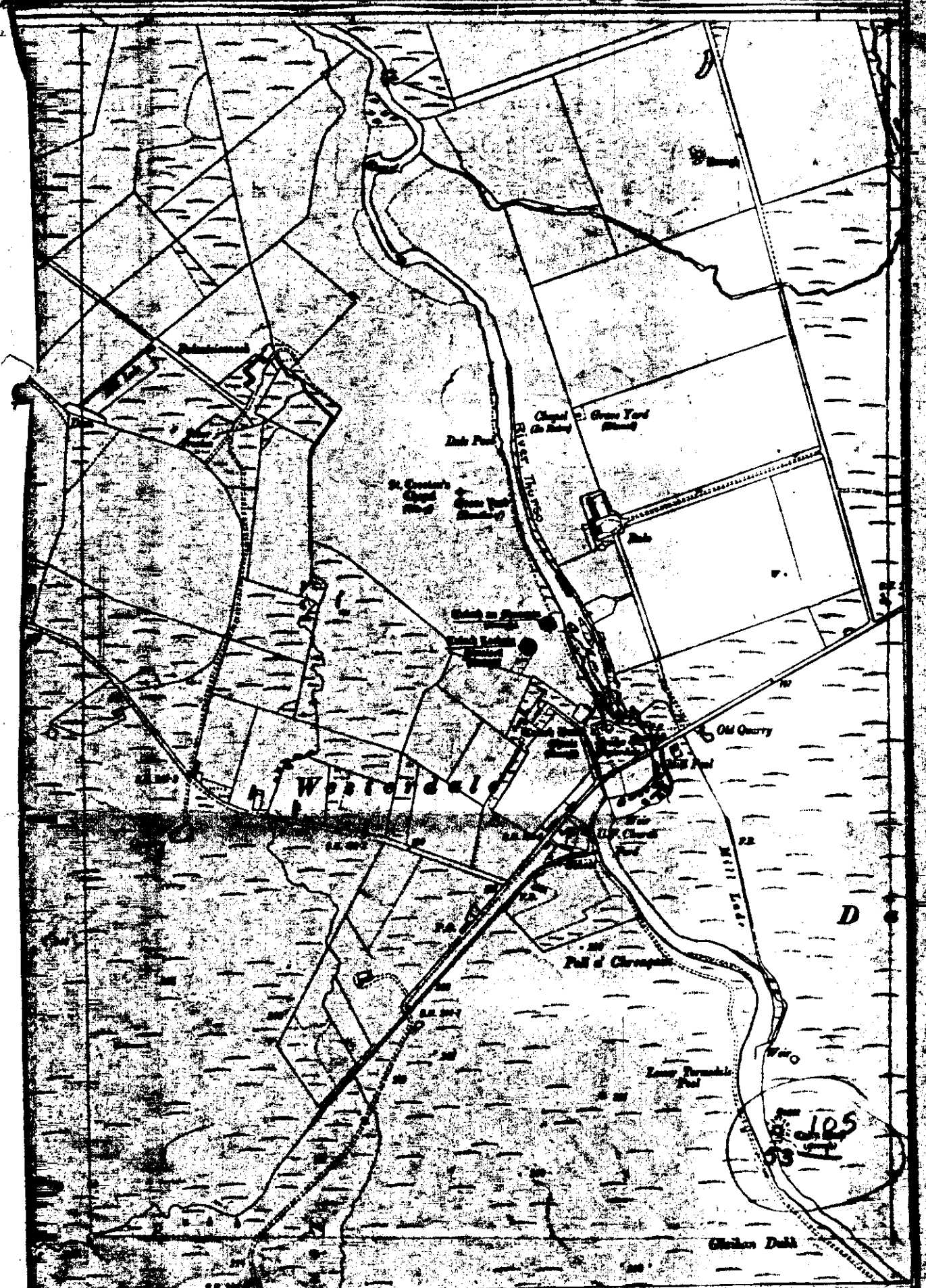
