Stemster Croft

situated in the Parish of Bower and  
County of Caithness

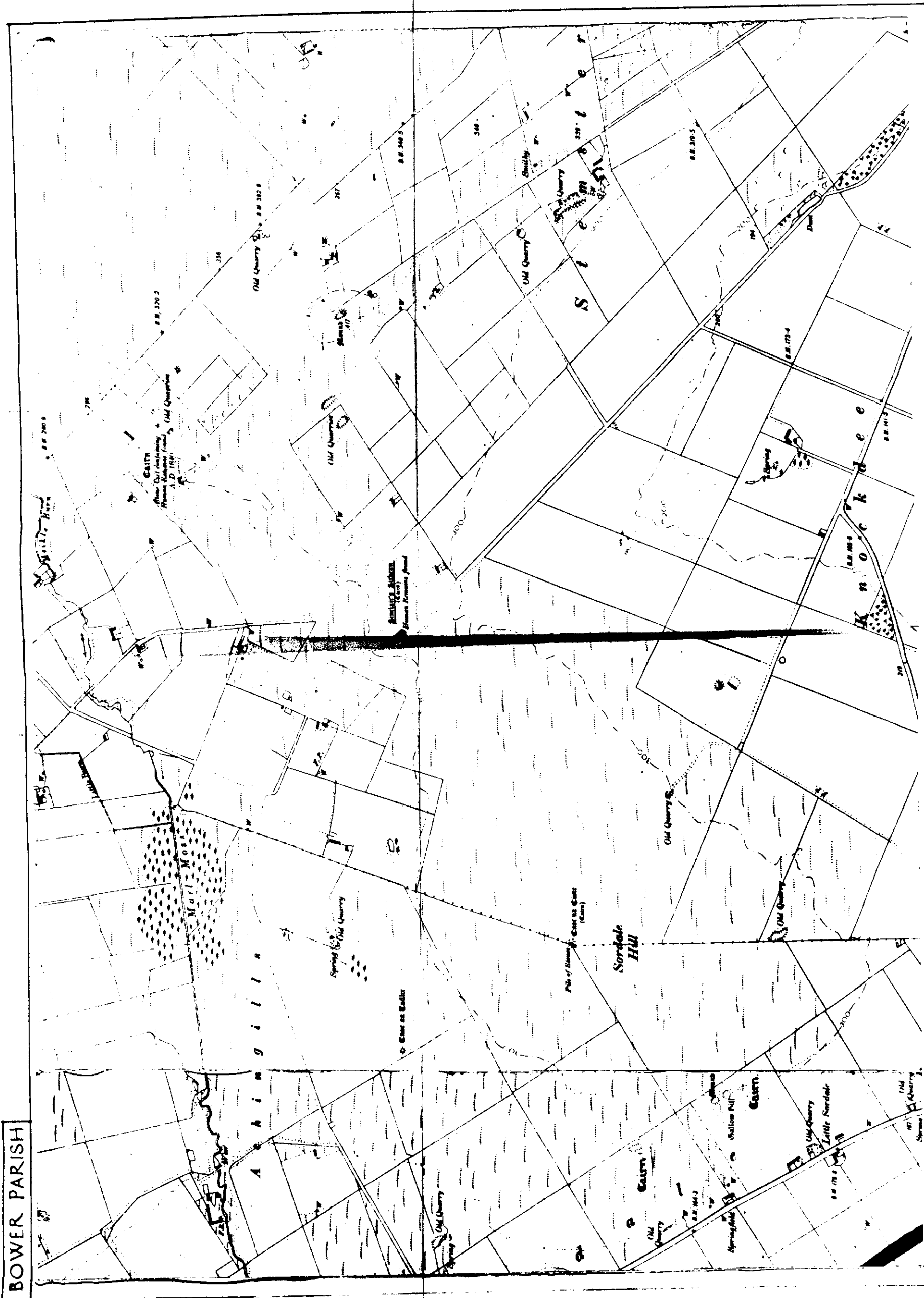
