

IN THE MATTER OF THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS ACTS, 1913 and 1931.

To James Auld, Esq., Hollandmake, Barrock, Thurso, Caithness

the owner of the Monument known as "Earl's Cairn" (chambered cairn) having a diameter of 42 feet, situated in a field 200 yards north of Hollandmaik, Instack, 1100 yards east of the bridge on the Thurso to John o'Groat's Road over the burn of Instack and 720 yards south-east of the junction of a track from said field to said road

being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as Hollandmaik or Hollandmake farm

situated in the Parish of Dunnet and County of Caithness

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Works and Public Buildings hereby give you notice that it is their intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by them under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act 1913.

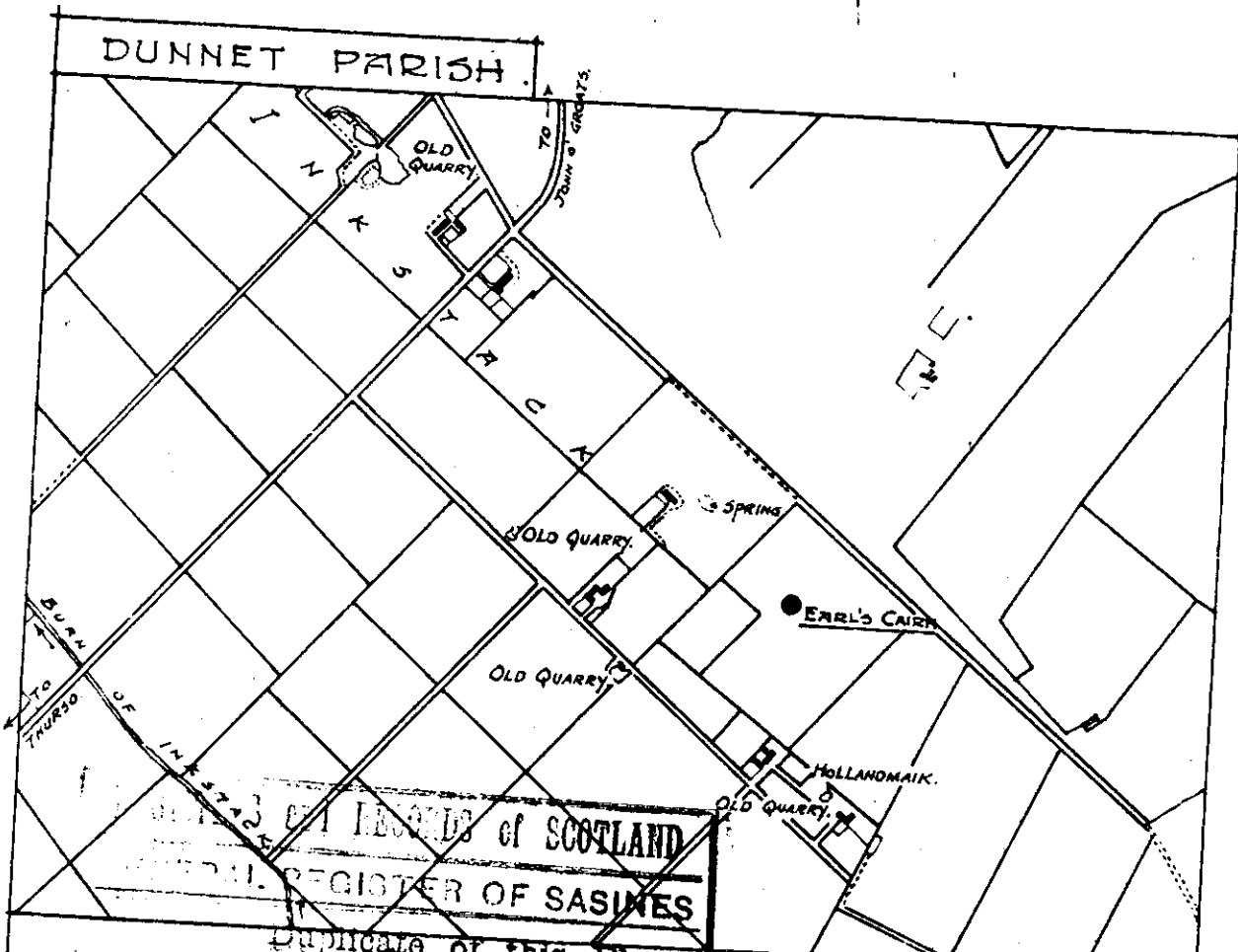

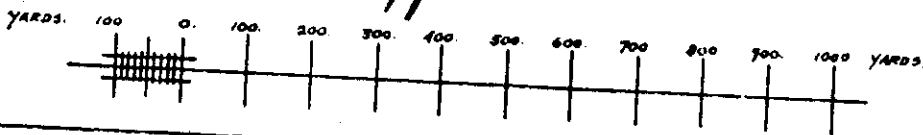
