To David Finlayson, Esq., and Mrs E. Finlayson. Ham, Scarsferry, Dunnet, Caithness the owner of the Monument known as Chambered cairn on the edge of a cliff on the Pentland Firth about 200 yards north-west of Ham and 570 yards north-north-east of Ham Cottage

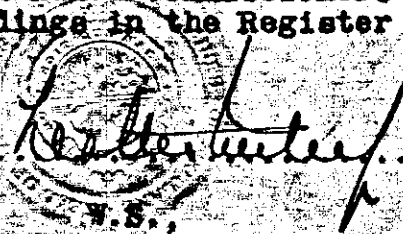

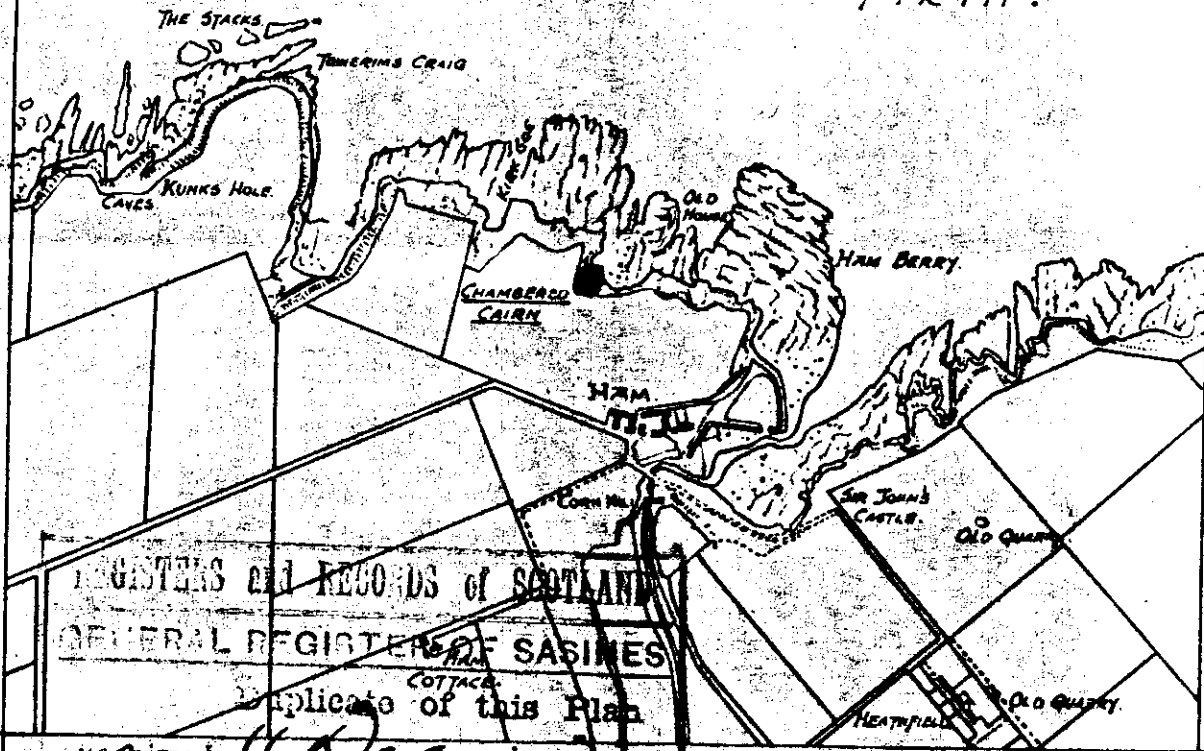

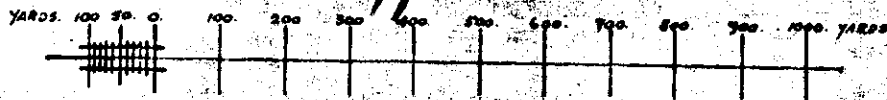
