Hempriggs House Lodge

IN THE MATTER OF THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS ACTS, 1913 AND 1931.

To Katharine Isobel Bennett Daw or Duff Dunbar of Tannach, Hempriggs House, Wick,

the owner of the Monument known as the Broch (or Brough) occupying a circular area of ground immediately to the south-east of the Lodge of Hempriggs House measuring fifty yards in diameter, the westmost point of said area being twenty yards south-east at its nearest point of the stream flowing through the Policies of said House to Loch Hempriggs, thirty yards east of the Bench Mark 158.3 on the bridge carrying the road between Lybster and Wick over said stream and four hundred and ten yards west by south of the westmost corner of said House

being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as Hempriggs Mansion House and Policies

situated in the Parish of Wick and County of Caithness.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Works and Public Buildings hereby give you notice that it is their intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by them under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

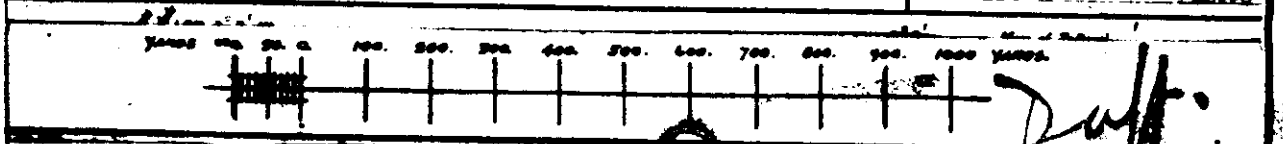
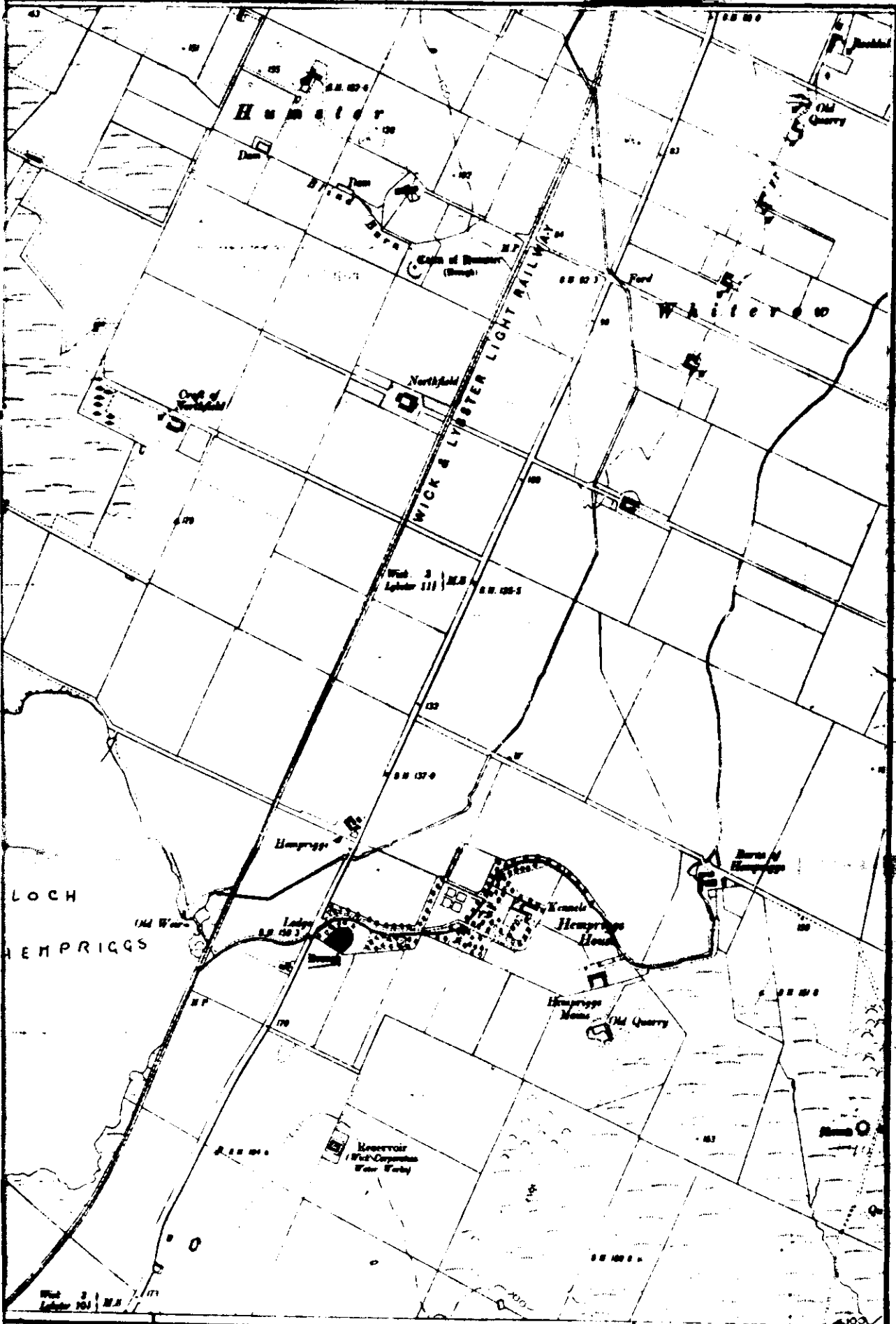
