

**IN THE MATTER OF THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS

To the Rt. Hon. Major Sir Archibald Henry Macdonald Sinclair, Bart.,
of Ulbster, per D.B. Keith, Esq., Factor, Thurso, Caithness,
the owner of the Monument known as Chambered cairn situated on the east
side of a track leading northward from Mains of Ulbster towards
an old quarry at Borrowston, and 1,000 yards north-north-west of
said Mains of Ulbster and 570 yards east of the Wick-Lybster road
at its nearest point
being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of
the property known as Ulbster Mains Farm

situated in the Parish of Wick and
County of Caithness

Act, 1931, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Works and Public Buildings hereby
give you notice that it is their intention to include the Monument above specified
in a list of monuments to be published by them under Section 12 of the Ancient
Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

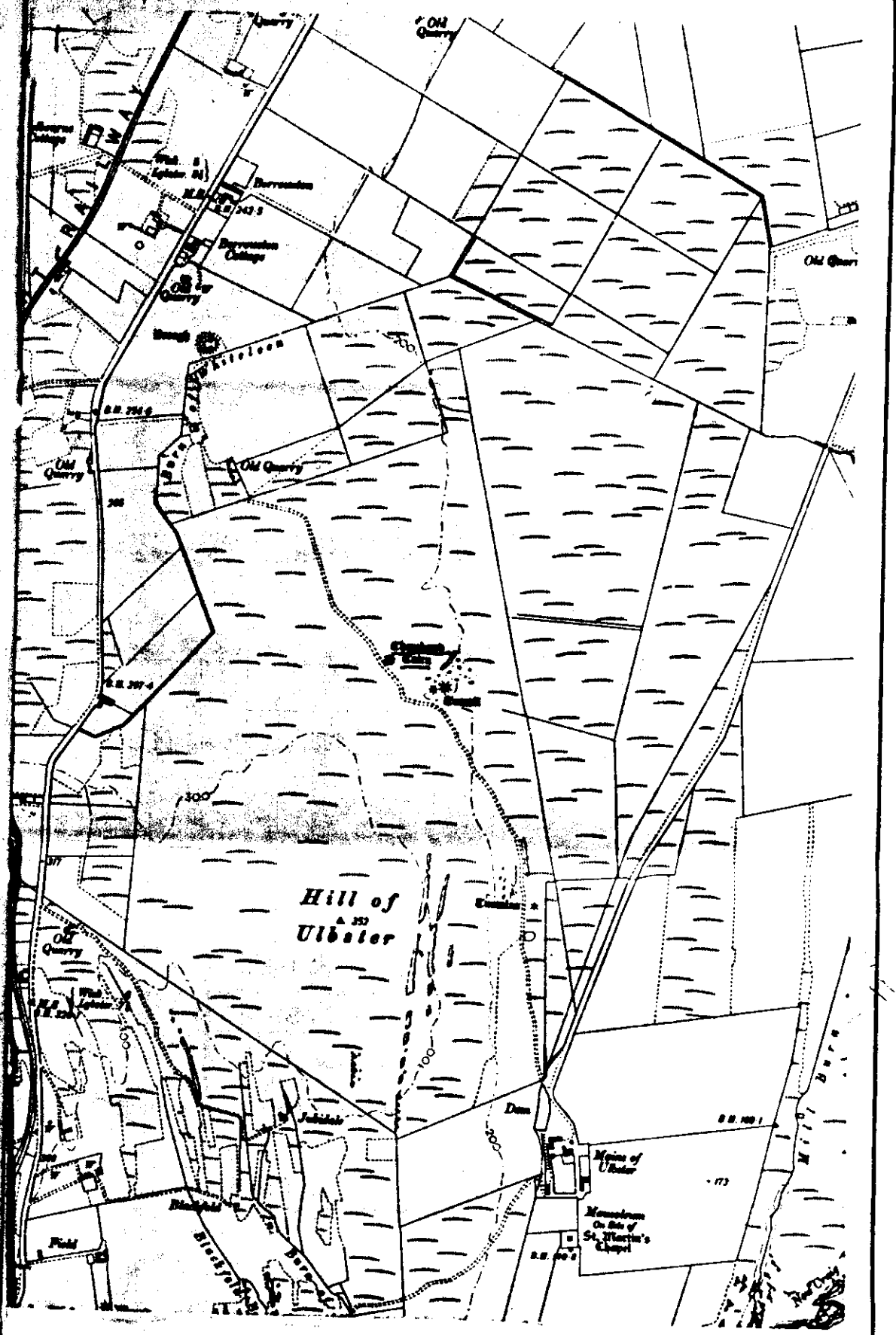
