the owner of the Monument known as the chambered cairn situated on the peninsula known as Rudh' an Dùnain 50 yards north of the north shore of Loch na h'Àirde at its nearest point, 90 yards south-east of high water mark at its nearest point on the north-west shore of said peninsula in Camas a' Mhùrain and 1,510 yards west by south of the confluence of the Allt ant-Sluichd Dhuibh and the Allt Sgurr nan Gearraill

being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as **Glenbrittle Farm**

situated in the Parish of **Bracadale** and  
County of **Inverness**

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Works and Public Buildings hereby give you notice that it is their intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by them under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.
