the owner of the Monuments known as Saint Columba's Church (in ruins), another church (in ruins), the mediaeval or late mediaeval grave-slabs and other ecclesiastical remains contained within Skeabost Island in the River Snizort the south-eastmost point of said Island being situated 80 yards north-west by west of Skeabost Bridge carrying the road from Portree to Bernisdale over said River, 140 yards north-east of the junction of said road with the road running parallel with the west or left bank of said River to Bracadale and 680 yards south-east by east of the north-east corner of Skeabost House

being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as the Estate of Skeabost

situated in the Parish of Snizort and
County of Inverness.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Works and Public Buildings hereby give you notice that it is their intention to include the Monuments above specified in a list of monuments to be published by them under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

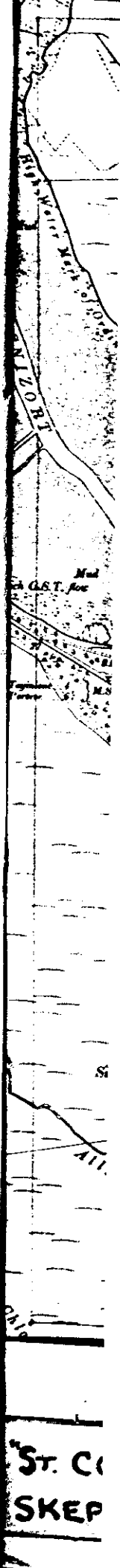
