"An urn, containing ashes and bones partially burnt, and a very thin copper coin, were found when digging the foundations of the minister's house in Strath." (1)

"It is known that the minister's house was built c.1825 (See NG 52 SE 10) and Mr. Alexander Stoddart of Kilbride informed me that his house, Kilbride, at NG 588203, was the minister's house until about 1910. The property has been in Mr. Stoddart's hands since 1924 but he has no knowledge of the urn or its whereabouts." (OSFI:CFW:20.6.1961)
