"NG 680 099: Enclosure or Hut Circle, Loch Borovaig." (1) (2)

"Some 300 yds (92.7m) N. of a dun (HNG 60 NE 005) is a circular enclosure 18'(5.6m) in diameter internally surrounded by a stone wall 4'(1.21m) thick and 1'(0.3m) high, of which the outer and inner facings of boulders remain. The entrance is from the E. A tortuous stone wall has been erected some distance to the N. and S. of the circle. This is probably of late date." (1)

"A hut circle as described by (1). It is situated on a sheltered shelf at NG 6811 1014. About 50.0m to the SW, built against a low rock face, there is a small circular hut measuring 2.0m in internal diameter, probably a shieling." (OSFI:AC:13.6.1961.)
