THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Caisteal Grugaig, broch 900m WSW of Totaig comprises a well preserved broch located in a clearing in a forestry plantation. The area to be scheduled measures 45m WSW-ENE by 45m NW-SE, to include the broch and an area around in which traces of activities associated with its construction and occupation may survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Glenshiel and the County of Ross and Cromarty as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part of the subjects described in the Disposition by Thomas Douglas Scott in favour of the Secretary of State for Scotland dated 15 May and recorded in the Division of the General Register of Sasines for the County of Ross and Cromarty on 8 June both in the year 1956 (the present owner whereof being the Secretary of State for Scotland per the Forestry Commission, North Scotland Conservancy, 21 Church Street, Inverness), is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

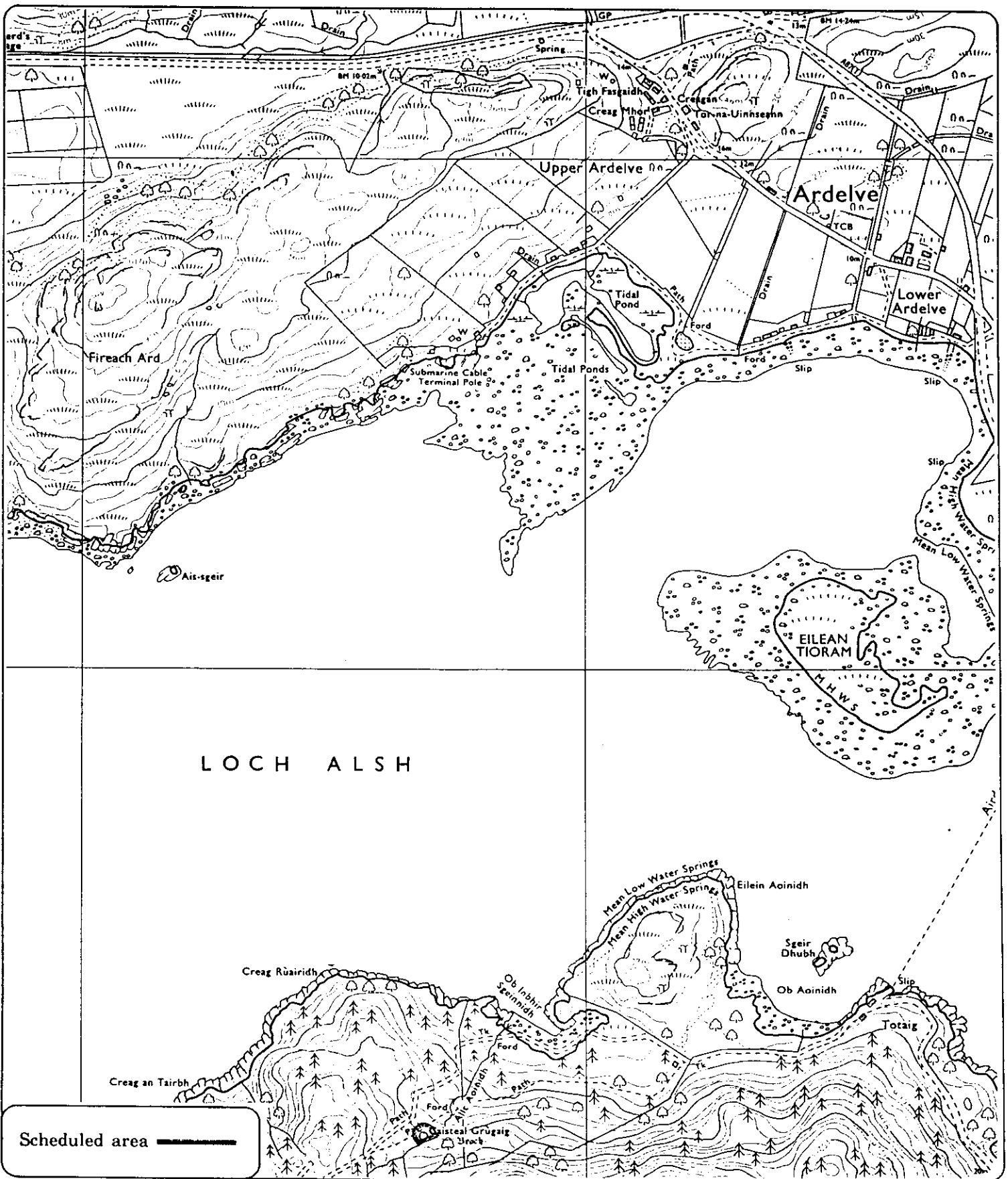

Scheduled area

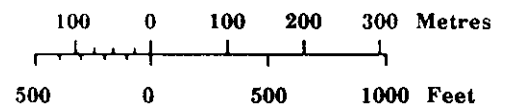
Caisteal Grugaig, broch 900m
