To Mrs Marjory Charlotte Mackenzie of Gairloch, per Factor, Estate Office, Urray, Muir of Ord, Ross-shire, Owner of the Monument consisting of a Chapel, burial ground and two cross incised grave slabs on Isle Maree shown coloured red on the annexed plan, lying in the Parish and County aftermentioned and forming part of the lands and Estate of Gairloch described in the Disposition by Sir Hector David Mackenzie in favour of Marjory Charlotte Mackenzie dated Twenty first July and recorded in the Division of the General Register of Sasines for the County of Ross and Cromarty on Twentieth September both months of Nineteen hundred and Sixty six, and also forming part of subjects (Twenty fifth) excepted in the Disposition by the said Marjory Charlotte Mackenzie in favour of John Alexander Mackenzie dated Fourth and recorded in the said Division of the General Register of Sasines on Twenty first both days August Nineteen hundred and Seventy three

situated in the Parish of Gairloch and County of Ross and Cromarty

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, as read with the Transfer of Functions (Scottish Royal Parks and Ancient Monuments) Order, 1969, the Secretary of State hereby gives notice that it is his intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by him under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

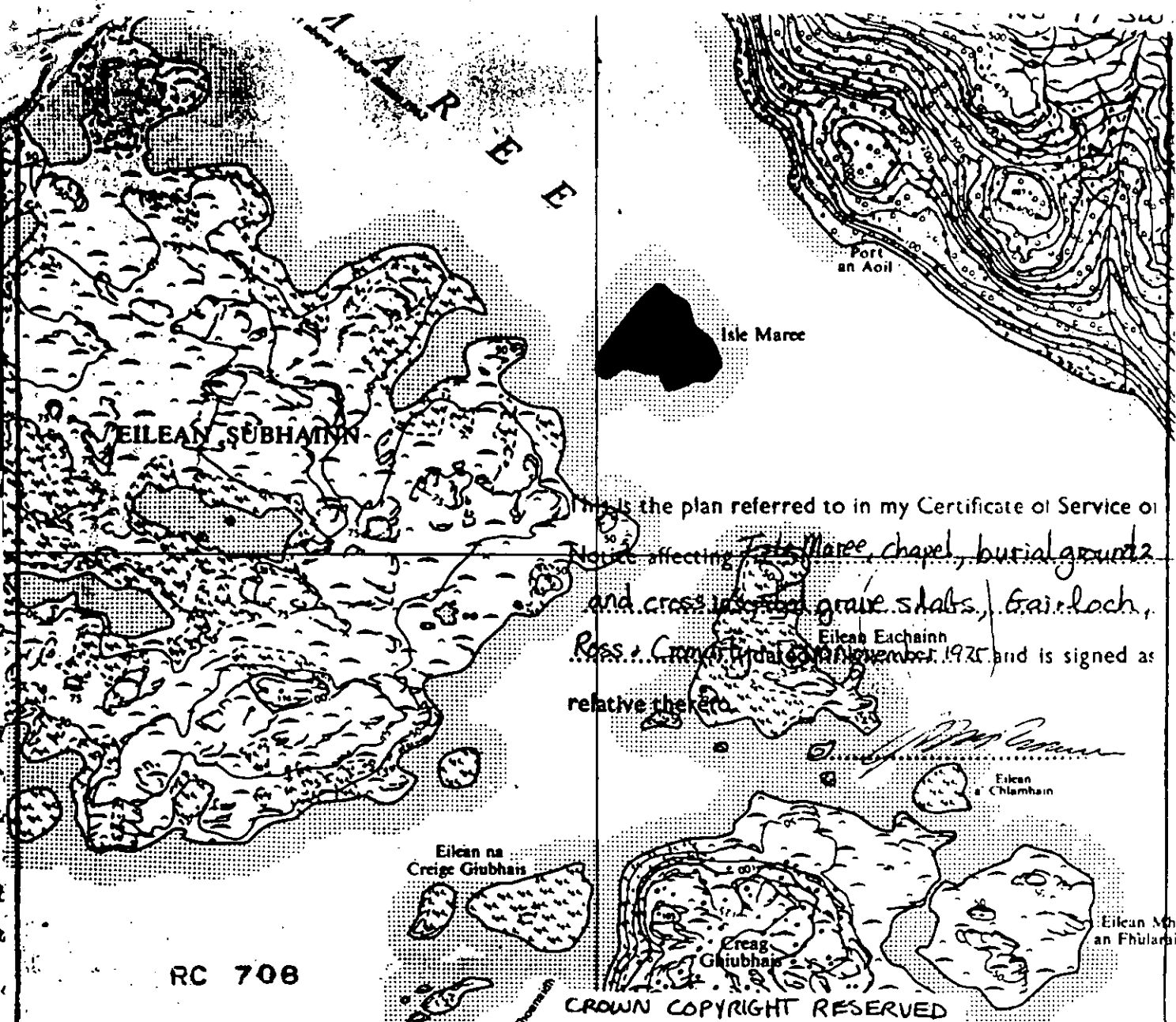

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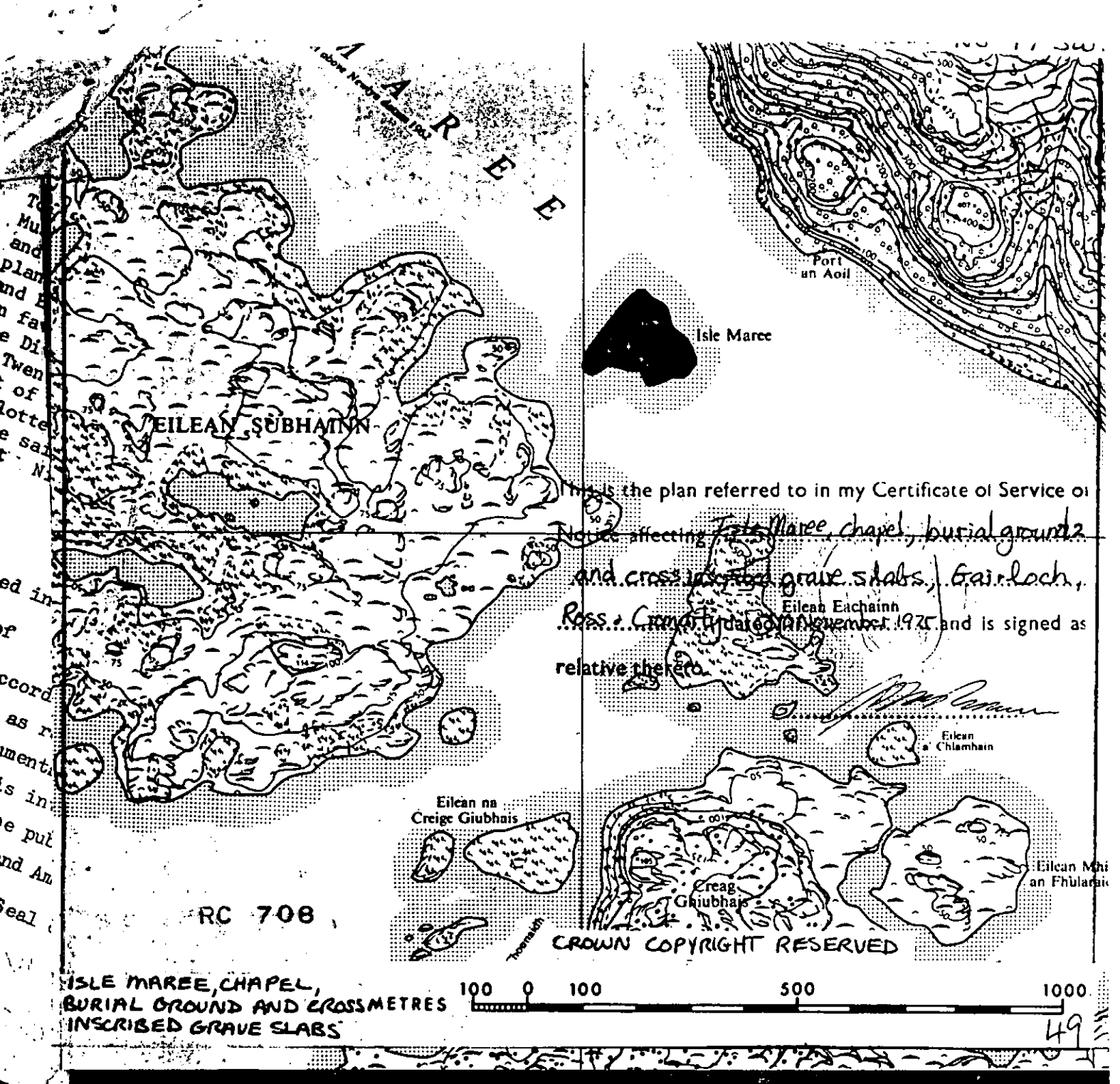
