"NH 541 421" Belladrum, chambered cairn 480m NW of" (6)

Belladrum (Kiltarlity Par., Inverness, x). In a wood on a gravel terrace about 100 feet above O.D., incomplete remains of a typical boulder peristalith 43 feet E. W. by perhaps 40 feet N.-S. enclosing denuded cairn. No chamber nor passage is exposed and no outer circle remains.

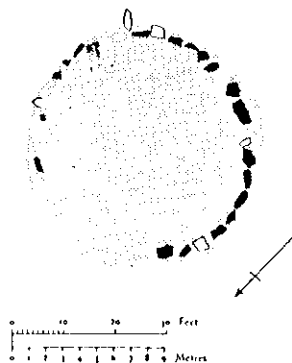
(fig. 89) *Visited 13.4.57*

Description. The site is in a small strip of waste woodland in the agricultural land of the Beaully valley, at 100ft. O.D. All that remains is a typical kerb of irregular heavy boulders, almost complete on the S half but with a considerable gap on the N. The tallest pointed stones occur on the SW side where they stand 2ft. 9in. to 3ft. 6in. above the present ground level. There has been no attempt to place the boulders to give a smooth outer face to the cairn. The diameter of the kerb E-W is 45ft. and N-S 42ft. A depth of some 1 or 2ft. of cairn material remains inside the kerb and also spreads a few feet beyond it.

There is no structure visible at the centre of the cairn, nor are there any monoliths surrounding it.
