THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS ACTS, 1913 AND 1931

To Peter George Loch McCallum, Esquire, Tulloch Street, Dingwall, (sometime of Mountgerald, Dingwall) Owner of the Monument known as Cille Bhrea (800 yards south of Lemlair) being the remains of a chapel measuring 35 ft by 14½ ft with grass covered walls standing 2 ft high and over 2 ft thick and with grave-slabs in the chapel and immediately to the north of it but the graveyard is unenclosed and derelict, all as shown coloured red on the annexed plan and forming part of the Farm and lands of Mountrich described in the Feu Disposition granted by Angus Douglas Vickers in favour of Peter William McCallum dated 16th May and recorded in the Division of the General Register of Sasines for the County of Ross and Cromarty on 16th June both in the year Nineteen hundred and fifty three, and

situated in the Parish of **Kiltearn**

and

County of **Ross and Cromarty**

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, as read with the Transfer of Functions (Scottish Royal Parks and Ancient Monuments) Order, 1969, the Secretary of State hereby gives notice that it is his intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by him under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

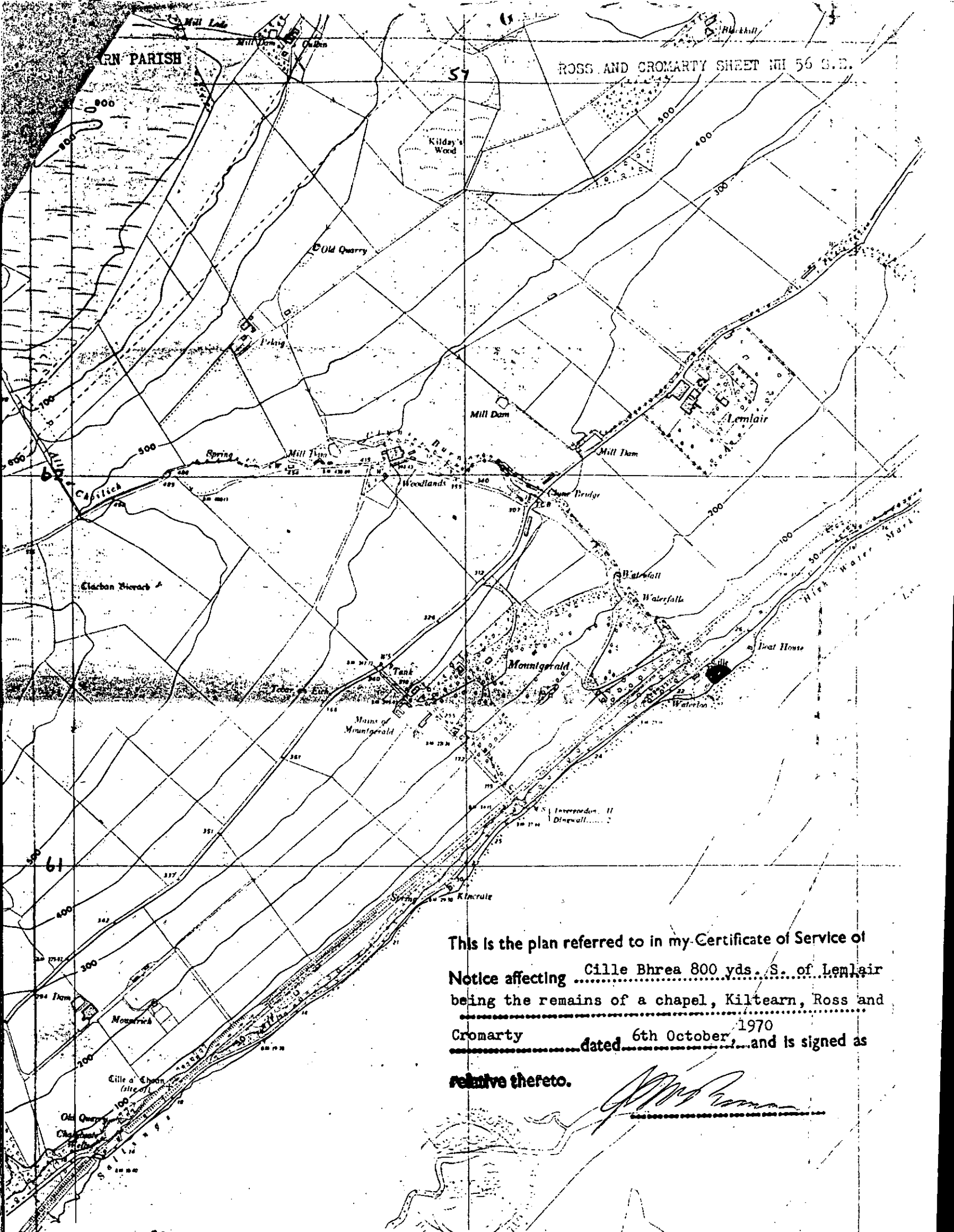
