 "Centred at NH 540 637 and set on a N-facing slope approx. 25m above the River Sgitheach is a settlement of three hut circles (A-C), all obscured by peat and heather. Hut 'A' is 10.5m E-W by 9.0m within a slight wall of indeterminate width. The entrance is in the E. 'B' and 'C' are circular and measure 8.0m and 8.5m in diameter respectively within walls of 2.5m average spread. The entrances, although not evident, were probably in the E sides. With the exception of one or two possible clearance heaps there is no trace of contemporary agriculture in the area, although the ground is of a fairly stone-free nature." (OSFI:JB:16.11.1976)
