"NH 57619673: Standing Stone." (1)

"A quadrangular standing stone facing north-south and measuring 5'5" in height above ground, 2'6" in breadth at base, and 1'5" near the upper end, and 1'4" in thickness. Some 4' to the S of it a stone, 5' in length and 7" to 8" in thickness, hog-backed in form, protrudes to a height of about 1' from the ground." (2)

"The stone is as described as is the stone 4ft to the south of it." (OSFI:EGC:8.6.1963)

"These stones are as described by previous authorities. According to the farmer, (Mr. Donald MacKay, Invershin Farm) large quantities of quartz are found in the vicinity of the stones whilst ploughing; much quartz was visible on the surface of the field which was under stubble at the time of investigation."
