'(NH 6426) A possible Clava cairn was situated at Duhallow of Aberarder. (1)'

'It was described by Fraser as a stone circle which was entirely cleared away by agricultural improvements c.1860 - "It showed indications of a small internal chamber and cairn, built on the inner circle ...no dimensions can now be got". (2)'

'No remains were seen in the area indicated. (OSFI:RDL:11.9.63)'
