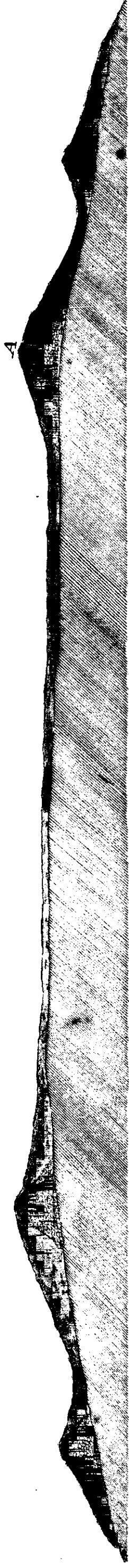


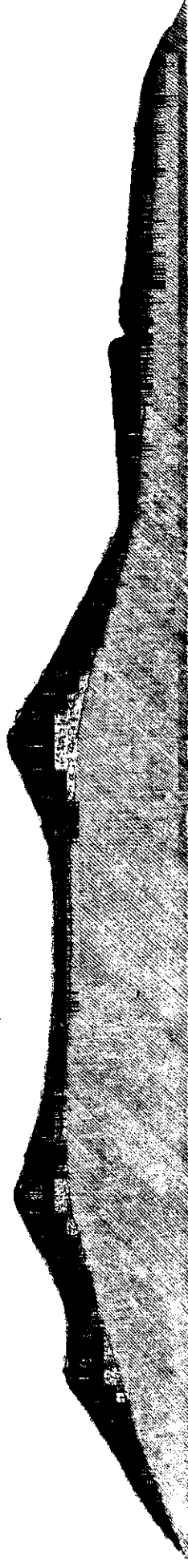
PLAN and SECTIONS of the VITRIFIED FORT on CRAIG-PHATRIC, near INVERNESS.

THE are trial pits sunk down to the Plum-pudding solid rock, and are in general about 4 feet deep.
