 "NH 6153 6568. Balconie House." (1) "Balconie Castle is on the site of one of the castles occupied by the Earls of Ross." (2) "Balconie House is a derelict four storey building. There is no trace of a former building to be seen. It is perhaps significant that the position is opposite Castlecraig (HNH 66 SW 002) which stands on the SE shore of Cromarty Firth and it is believed locally that a castle guarded the firth on each side here." (OSFI:RDL:5.5.1963)
