

IN THE MATTER OF THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS ACTS, 1913 and 1931.

To Captain Charles John Shaw-Mackenzie of Newhall, per Messrs. John C. Brodie & Sons, W.S., 5, Thistle Street, Edinburgh, 2. the owner of the Monument known as Castle Craig, situated on a cliff on the Black Isle on the southern shore of the Cromarty Firth, approximately 400 yards west of Craigton and 900 yards north-east of Easter Toberchurn, being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as Newhall Estate

situated in the Parish of Resolis and County of Ross and Cromarty.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 8 of the Ancient Monuments Act 1931, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Works and Public Buildings hereby give you notice that it is their intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by them under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act 1913.

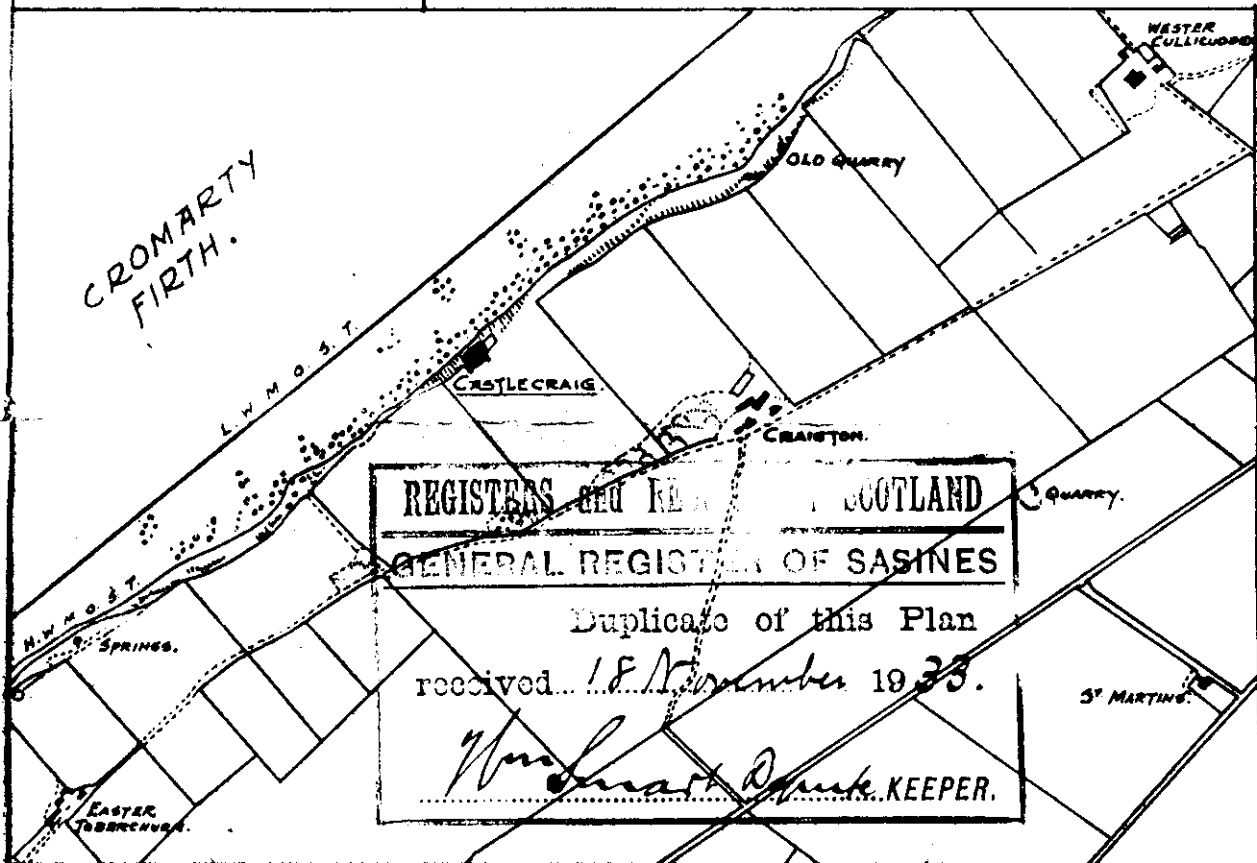

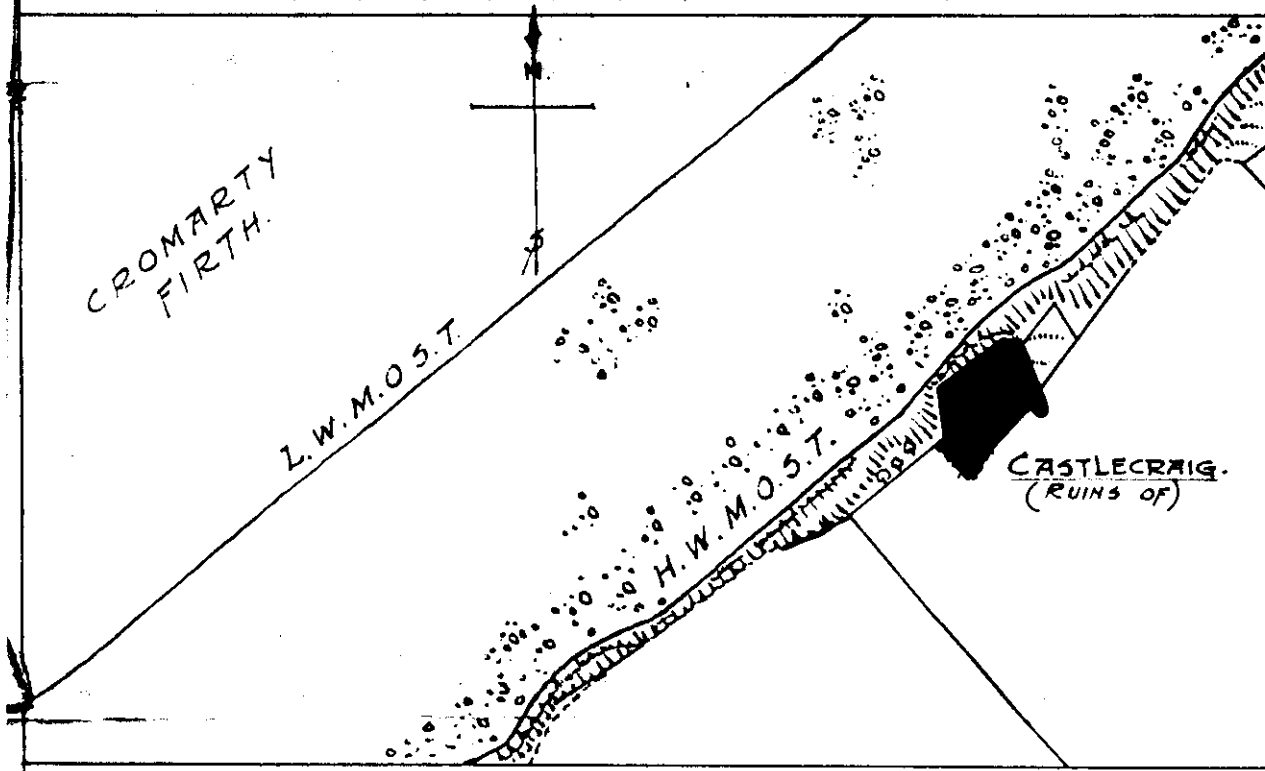
