 "Of Kinbeachie Castle, formerly a seat of the Urquharts, only the south gable remains. It contains a fireplace over which is a panel dated: 1546. The other walls are reduced to foundation level."

 "MacDopnald and Ross say that another panel, dated 1612, is now in the National Portrait Gallery, Edinburgh."
 "The remains of Kinbeachie Castle comprise the SE wall and the foundations of the NE, NW and SW walls. The SE wall, 1.2 m in width; is extant to a maximum height of 1.7 m and the total length is 6.6 m externally. It is rubble masonry, but the E and S angles have been constructed of dressed stones." (OSFI:RB:24.1.1966)
