 "NH 6700 7348. Achnaicloich Castle (remains of)." (1) "The castle of the lairds of Achnaicloich stood 200yds E of the loch of Achnaicloich. It is now all removed but for a portion of the dungeon." (2) "The OS 25" plan shows a small yard 3m x 2m at Nh 6700 7348 as 'Achnaicloich Castle (remains of'. This feature, on the S slope of a natural flat-topped knoll, is now hidden beneath a heap of field stones, only one small earth-fast stone was seen. No visible traces of the castle remain." (OSFI:WDJ:9.5.1963)
