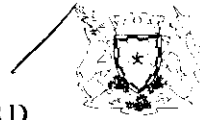

"The site of this cairn, on a slope, is occupied by a small quarry c.7.0m in diameter. From its position and small size, it seems likely that it was a clearance heap, possibly contemporary with HNH 78 NE 002." (MSFI: AA: 31.3.1971.)

"The Ordnance Survey cards for HNH 78 NE 002 record a settlement ('A'-'Z'). Additional sites were found on the 1906 Ordnance Survey 25" map and grid references were given to the ones ignored on the cards. A sketch map was drawn showing every site listed above." (GS: 29.5.1985.)

Drurdivan Hut Circle

Part of the Camore Wood settlement, Hut Circle 'A' has a diameter c. 13.5m, with an entrance in the SW. Taken from the NW.
