"(NH 7190 8420) Standing Stone (Sculptured)." (1).
 "An erect cross-slab of red sandstone 6 ft 3 ins (c 1.9m) high, 2ft 3ins (c 0.68m) wide, 8 ins (c 0.2m) thick at the bottom and 5ins (c 0.12m) thick at the top. The two lower horsemen are concealed by the ground." (2).
 "This cross-slab is as described and illustrated by Allen." (OSFI:ES:13.3.1963).
 "(NH 7190 8420) Cross Slab (Site of)." (3).
 "The cross slab stands at NH 7190 8420 in the graveyard of Edderton Free Church. It does not appear to have been moved in recent times. On the W face is an incised Celtic Cross, on the E a latin cross and a horseman in relief with two incised horsemen partly visible above ground level (OSFI:JB:27.2.1981)."
