

IN THE MATTER OF THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS ACTS, 1913 AND 1931.

To the Right Honourable John Duncan Vaughan Earl Cawdor, Cawdor Castle, Nairn,

the owner of the Monument known as Rait Castle contained within a rectangular area of ground measuring 150 ft. on each of its northwest and southeast sides and 125 ft. on each of its northeast and southwest sides, the westmost corner of said area being situated 1,300 ft. east by south of the Geddes Burn at its nearest point; 1,400 ft. southeast by east of the south gable of the main block of buildings at Raitcastle and 2,000 ft. or thereby southwest by south of the road between Nairn and Grantown-on-Spey at its nearest point

being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as the Thanage and Barony of Cawdor

situated in the Parish of Auldearn and County of Nairn.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Minister of Works hereby give you notice that it is his intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by him under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.
