 "NH 9317 2043. Bigla's Chair."(1) "A large fragment of rock said to have been used by Bigla Cumin (E. 15c of NH 91 NW 4) as a 'loupin'-on-stane' in her journeys to and from the church at Duthil. It is also said that on this stone she received the rents of her estate. The stone is not unlike a chair in form."(2)(3) "Unable to locate this rock, area now covered by a dense plantation."(OSFI:RL:2.11.1966)
