This form is for use in applying for consent to do works affecting a monument scheduled as of national importance under the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979 (hereinafter referred to as the 1979 Act).

IMPORTANT: Please check whether you require planning permission, or permission under any other enactments, in addition to scheduled monument consent. (Listed building consent under the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Acts is not required where the scheduled monument is also listed as a building of special architectural or historic interest under those Acts).

CENERAL

Under section 2 of the 1979 Act it is an offence to do works affecting a scheduled monument without the prior written consent of the Secretary of State ("scheduled monument consent"). Such works are defined as

"any works resulting in the demolition or destruction of or any damage to a scheduled monument;

any works for the purpose of removing or repairing a scheduled monument or any part of it or of making any alterations or additions thereto; and

any flooding or tipping operations on land in, on or under which there is a scheduled monument."

Consent may be granted subject to conditions or may be refused and, if so, compensation may be available.

CERTIFICATE OF OWNERSHIP AND NOTIFICATION TO JOINT OWNERS

When completed, this form must be accompanied by one of the appended certificates A, B, C or D about your ownership of the monument and the notice given to joint owners about your application for consent. The form of the notice to be given to joint owners is also appended.
