

LOCHINDORB TOURIST POTENTIAL TO BE TAPPED

PLANS to partially restore Lochindorb Castle and provide car parking and ferry facilities to the 14th century structure on Dava Moor which was once the home of the notorious Wolf of Badenoch, have been announced.

The scheme is being proposed by owner of the site, Lord Cawdor and would be undertaken by the Manpower Services Commission with help from Highland Regional Council.

The council has agreed to allow its archeologist, Mr Bob Gourley to assist in survey and excavation work.

Lochindorb was once the main castle of the Comyns and was probably erected before they became Lords of Badenoch in the early 13th century.

It was captured by Edward I of England during his punitive expedition to the north in 1303 and was subsequently rebuilt by the English.

Alexander Stewart, the notorious Wolf of Badenoch, once lived there and it was from Lochindorb he set out to burn Forres and Elgin in 1372. The castle was dismantled by royal decree less than a century later and the great iron door was moved to Cawdor Castle, where it remains.

Mr Harold Wilkinson, the region's leisure director, commenting on the scheme, said: "It

will provide a unique visitor experience of wide-ranging interest in a part of the region otherwise poorly provided for in this respect."
