52 TEXT

"NH 904 803. Dun, Tarrel: This dun occupies the summit of a rocky knoll overlooking the sea-shore. The dun wall has been destroyed on the seaward side, but elsewhere it measures up to 3.7 m by 6.7 m." (1)

"The dun at NH 9046 8034 is oval. The rocky knoll on which it is sited is connected on the landward side by a narrow isthmus of rock. Overall the dun measures 11.0 m E-W by 7.0 m; little remains of the wall except on the approachable W side where a disfigured wall or revetment stands 0.9 m high. On the other three sides the position is naturally defended."
